70:00	FULL TIME: Good win to AUS. They now have two wins and 19 goals from two matches. Their next match against PAK should determine the final placings in Pool C. BEL tried throughout but were no match for one of the tournament favourites
69:20	Goal AUS Goal. Des Abbott swats the goal after Hotchkis pass from the right side deflected by Davidson
68:13	AUS still working hard and looking to press forward at every opportunity. BEL struggling to keep up
63:14	Great stick save by AUS goalkeeper
62:24	BEL PC
60:24	Goal AUS Goal. Good team goal. Ball travelled through Charlesworth and Davidson, among others, before Hotchkis converted from close range
59:59	Hennessy misses chance to score fourth goal. His shot was mishit and off target
59:26	Variation almost successful as Paterson just misses tapping the ball into the net on the left post
57:59	AUS PC
57:30	Good interchange of passes between Hotchkis, Paterson and Charlesworth comes to nothing as the final pass goes astray inside the BEL circle. AUS still looking dangerous as BEL tire
54:06	Goal AUS Goal. Iain Davidson found space behind the defence and as he attempted

	to round the BEL goalkeeper, the ball squeezed to Hennessy and he made no mistake slotting it into the open net
52:26	Skill errors leading to a string of turnovers from both teams as the pace of the match slows compared to the first half
50:25	AUS goalkeeper David Reid makes save with left foot from Schuemrman`s low flick
48:54	BEL PC. Deliberate infraction by AUS inside the 25 yard area
45:54	Knowles easily saves Alexandre de Daedeleer flick on the right post
45:02	2nd PC awarded to BEL
44:23	BEL PC. Off a foot of AUS defender inside circle
41:41	Des Abbott (AUS) saved by BEL goalkeeper. The shot came after a period of frantic play inside the circle
37:59	Goal AUS Goal. Unlucky goal conceded by BEL. Knowles shot from the right deflected in by BEL defender after it looked like to miss
35:00	HALF TIME: A very enjoyable half to watch, with both teams throwing everything into attack. A late goal to AUS would please their coaching staff after they began to lose patience and rush their play in attack towards the end of the first half. BEL putting in another spirited performance and are worrying AUS with speed through the midfield at various stages
34:42	Goal AUS Goal. Brown brilliance gives Hennessy his second goal and a vital one for AUS just before half time. Brown dribbled into the heavily congested circle, travelled to the backline to the left of goal and pass across the face for Hennessy to tap in once again
34:24	Glenn Turner creates another chance for AUS with neat skills, but ultimately the final pass was to the wrong side of Colin Hennessy and he wasn`t able to control the ball and get a shot on target
32:11	AUS still looking threatening in attack, but their finishing touches have deserted them since midway through the half. A number of chances aren`t being capitalised on
31:01	The goal was a good reward for BEL who are showing great enthusisam and a willingness to challenge AUS. They have looked more in control in the last 10-15 minutes
29:28	Goal After the third or fourth chance from a scramble after the intitial PC has broken down, Truyens stabbed the ball into the goal
28:20	BEL PC. AUS foot inside the circle
28:03	BEL looking dangerous on the counter attack, but AUS defecne able to cover at this stage
26:02	Brown again solid in defence for AUS. Jerome Truyens (BEL) showed good speed and control and raced clear down the inside leftchannel and passed to John-John Dohem on the right. However Brown made a crucial tackle to stop the movement
23:11	Narrow miss by AUS. Mark Paterson and Iain Davidson combined down the right but Daniel Hotchkis couldn`t convert a difficult chance with a deflection in front of goal
20:51	Goal line stop by Kiel Brown (AUS) saved a certain BEL goal. BEL captain Mike

	Deweever broke free from the midfield and off-loaded to Maxime Tys. His shot was headed to goal before Brown intervened and cleared the line
19:09	Double save by BEL keeper under immense pressure. AUS swept into circle with precise passing but Walravens was more than up to the challenge
16:54	BEL must try and tighten their structure and not be caught by AUS high-tempo style.
15:48	Hennessy low drag flick to the right is easily saved and cleared
14:57	AUS PC
14:47	Hennessy is released into space by a clever pass from Jonathan Charlesworth in the midfield. However his shot is well wide
13:10	Save by BEL goalkeeper. Tom Cleghorn works his way into the circle but his shot is well-stopped by Quentin Walravens. The rebound is cleared by BEL defence
11:25	Defensive error by AUS gives BEL good possession in their attacking half. However Joel Carrol (AUS) works hard to stop the movement before it reaches the circle
08:33	Fast-paced match with both teams looking to attack at every chance.
07:20	Knowles in the action in defence this time, covering a potentially dangerous BEL pass into the circle
04:27	Goal AUS Goal. Spectacular goal from AUS captain Mark Knowles. He controlled a bouncing ball, beat a defender near half way line and left defenders in his wake on an angled run to the circle. At the top of circle, he launched a diving reverse stick into the right side netting. The goal of the tournament so far.
01:33	Goal AUS Goal. AUS waste not time picking up from yesterday. A free hit from Kiel Brown from the left edge of the circle is tapped in by Colin Hennessy, the player who ignited the AUS avalanche yesterday.
00:02	Welcome to the second day of the Rabo Hockey Junior World Cup from Rotterdam. Almost 50 goals were scored yesterday and today should be no exception. AUS notched 12 yesterday against CHI, while BEL challenged PAK before conceding two late goals to lose.
