Time	Commentary
70:00	FULL TIME: A great win to ESP. They dominated throughout with their defence leading the way.
68:40	IND have no answers to the ESP defence. They have dominated all match
65:36	ESP long corner
64:18	ESP slowing the play down trying to wind down the clock
63:16	ESP with attack into IND circle
59:47	Great stick save by IND keeper. Long ball from Enrique (ESP) to Borrell left him needing only the keeper. Good piece of play all round
58:17	IND long corner
56:44	<b>Goal</b> ESP Goal. Juan Lainz on the end of great skills and a weaving run into the circle by Hector Martinez
56:19	ESP defence in total control
54:53	ESP stream forward but shot is high and wide of the goal
53:49	ESP looking good. Playing with confidence and giving IND little space
51:50	IND bring ball forward but again the ESP defence is up to the challenge
50:51	Another ESP shot at goal, this time by Pepe Borrell
50:23	Intercept from Alegre who takes ball into circle and forces save from IND keeper
47:19	IND concede free hit for pushing, relieving pressure on ESP
46:53	IND free hit on edge of circle
46:05	ESP with numbers around the ball in defence look solid
44:40	<b>Goal</b> ESP Goal. Alegre scores with a well taken shot from the top left of the circle. Good control and movement by ESP
44:31	ESP pressing with ball deep in attack

<b>41:23</b>	Sandeep Singh flick saved
<b>40:33</b>	IND PC
<b>40:02</b>	IND supporters urging their players on as they try to come back from a two-goal deficit
<b>38:59</b>	ESP narrow miss at the other end of the ground. Match has started brightly after the break
<b>37:42</b>	Sandeep Singh flicks wide
<b>36:46</b>	IND PC. Positive start to the half by IND
<b>36:24</b>	IND carry ball into the circle but ESP block
<b>35:07</b>	Second half underway. IND with the ball and with ground to make up
<b>35:00</b>	HALF TIME: ESP making the most of their chances while the IND strikers look a little flat, allowing ESP defence to get to the ball first
<b>32:09</b>	Jorge Rodriguez (ESP) flick tipped over the cross bar by the runner
<b>31:25</b>	ESP PC. Hit foot of IND defender inside circle from a free hit to the right
<b>30:09</b>	IND miss great chance to score. Ball across face of goal can't be trapped by two IND attackers
<b>28:50</b>	<b>Goal</b> ESP Goal. Initial flick was saved but Sergio Enrique swooped on the loose ball and flung the ball home. ESP with significant lead
<b>28:03</b>	ESP PC. ESP work ball into the circle from the free hit for the PC
<b>27:06</b>	Two ESP players in a row hit in the head and mouth by IND sticks raised high after the umpire's whistle. Both are ok
<b>25:20</b>	Fast break to ESP breaks down at vital moment
<b>25:05</b>	ESP goalkeeper Andreu Mollet forced to come of his line to block an IND entry into the circle
<b>23:40</b>	ESP methodical with the ball and satisfied to throw the ball around at the back until something opens up. IND mostly keeping their structure
<b>22:13</b>	IND and ESP look like they are still trying to get the measure of each other
<b>21:50</b>	Nothing much of note happening. Match oscillating between each goal circle. Neither team can get on top
<b>21:04</b>	An IND drummer has started playing in the stands as the match lulls slightly
<b>17:29</b>	This match is developing into a tight contest of good standard
<b>15:43</b>	ESP defender Andreu Enrich makes another strong tackle in the circle
<b>14:12</b>	IND long corner
<b>13:56</b>	IND break free on the counter attack and only a lunging tackle stops them before the circle
<b>12:54</b>	Sandeep Singh (IND) fires a ball into the circle but neither can handle it
<b>11:26</b>	ESP defence forced to clear cross into the circle from IND
<b>09:44</b>	Stop on the goal line by Sergio Enrique (ESP)
<b>09:37</b>	IND PC
<b>09:17</b>	Green Card Vivek Gupta (IND)
<b>08:58</b>	IND controlling the midfield but both teams look fluent
<b>07:43</b>	IND attack amounts to nothing as ESP stop the movement

<b>06:53</b>	The goal resulted from ESP`s first foray into the IND circle
<b>04:36</b>	<b>Goal</b> ESP Goal. ESP captain David Alegre converts penalty stroke. IND goalkeeper Adrian D`Souza got his body to the ball but the pace was too much to stop completely
<b>04:00</b>	ESP Stroke. Strong run in the circle by Juan Fernandez forces IND defence into mistake which results in a pebalty stroke
<b>03:06</b>	Neither team making an impression at this stage, although IND have had most of the possession
<b>01:50</b>	An interesting match expected between two of the fancied teams in Pool E
<b>00:24</b>	Match Underway
