70:00	FULL TIME: AUS qualify for the semi finals with a comprehensive win. GER must beat BEL tomorrow and hope that ARG falls to AUS in order to make the semi finals themselves
65:37	Flick saved by AUS GK
65:03	GER PC. AUS defenders obstruct Oliver Korn (AUS) in circle
63:06	Ball rolls over the back line
62:40	AUS PC
60:52	<b>Goal</b> After free hit was cleared. AUS won the ball in midfield and pushed forward. Another free hit near the circle was received by Ockenden, who turned on his defedner and fired a low reverse stick
59:51	AUS free hit on edge of circle
58:54	Glenn Turner (AUS) busy in attack and finding a lot of ball as his team streams forward in waves
55:34	<b>Goal</b> With Smyth back on the field, AUS score again, this time Des Abbott converting from mid-circle
53:26	<b>Goal</b> AUS Goal. Against the run of play, a long ball out of defence found Glenn Turner in space on the right. He threw a well-weighted, angled ball to Cleghorn, who picked it up at the top of the circle, jinked over the GER GK and calmly pushed the ball into the net.
52:45	AUS have not had the ball for any length of time since Smyth was sent off

51:56	With the extra man, GER are putting AUS under immense pressure
49:56	<b>Goal</b> GER Goal. Timo Witthaus converts from close range
48:22	AUS with all players behind the ball as GER keep up pressure
47:42	AUS with all players behind the ball as GER keep up pressure
46:54	<b>Incident</b> Yellow Card Ian Smyth (AUS)
46:34	GER free hit near circle hits foot of own player
45:52	Green Card Mark Paterson (AUS)
45:11	Good low tackle by Kiel Brown ends GER attack
44:29	Burcher in good position to deflect GER pass outside circle
43:57	Both captains receive a warning after tempers become heated inside AUS circle
43:14	GER still in attack
42:58	GER stream forward but AUS GK blocks the attempted cross with his stick
41:25	Hennessy chips a reverse stick over the crossbar. He was released into space by a clever overhead
37:43	<b>Goal</b> Hennessy's low drag flick spears into the left corner
36:30	AUS PC. Turnover and AUS take ball into circle
36:22	AUS with huge pressure on the GER ball carrier
35:16	Play underway in 2nd half
35:00	HALF TIME: A dominant first 25 minutes from AUS. GER couldn't find any rhythm but managed to get a more even share of possession and field territory late in the half. With a three-goal lead, AUS should go on to claim a spot in the semi finals
34:21	AUS GK clears dangerous cross from the right and AUS clear to other end of the pitch
33:37	GER getting their passing combinations together but last line of AUS defence is holding well
31:28	GER in attack
29:46	AUS GK David Reid makes an easy glove save from deflection. GER having good period of play with the ball
27:41	GER being rushed into making bad decisions when trying to outlet from defence
26:16	<b>Goal</b> AUS Goal. Rebound fell to Colin Hennessy on the top right of the circle. He had time to pick his spot and smash the ball home
25:36	AUS PC. Strong run from Mark Knowles into circle
24:37	GER GK forced to make another good save
24:20	GER probing trying to find a way through the AUS defence, but AUS are able to make the interception and break through the midfield
17:54	<b>Goal</b> AUS Goal. Free hit near edge of circle is received by Eddie Ockenden, who makes no mistake. AUS playing too high a tempo for GER. GER need to slow AUS play and concentrate on reducing their defensive turnovers

<b>17:32</b>	Anticipation by Maximilian Mueller (GER) intercepts a Des Abbott pass from the right wing as AUS found space down the sideline
<b>15:58</b>	AUS break free from deep inside own territory
<b>12:27</b>	AUS in total control. They are running hard and creating space at will. GER GK Nicolas Jacobi has been under siege in the first 10 minutes of the match
<b>11:22</b>	Burcher`s repeat effort is too high
<b>10:53</b>	AUS PC
<b>06:45</b>	AUS dominating. GER not match at this stage
<b>06:22</b>	Apologies for the delay in commentary. Hopefully now things will be back to normal.
<b>04:04</b>	<b>Goal</b> AUS Goal. Ian Burcher crushes a penalty hit into the right corner of the backboard
<b>03:38</b>	AUS PC
<b>00:02</b>	Match underway with GER in possession
<b>00:00</b>	This is a virtual knock-out match. AUS can secure a place in the semi finals with a win, while GER won`t want to drop any more points with only two more Pool matches remaining. Match will begin at 14:30 local time
