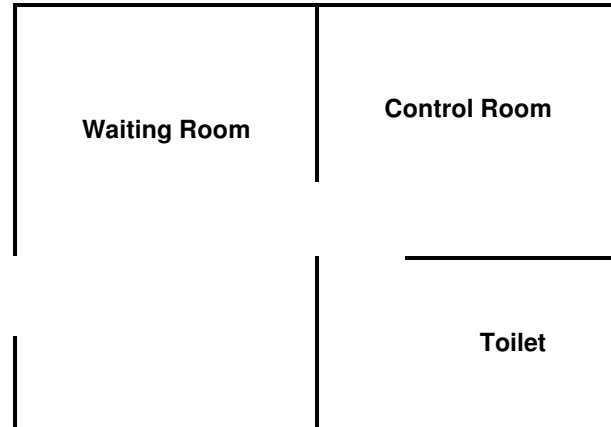


**These notes describe the requirements for a doping control area at an FIH competition.**

A room of adequate size with lavatory (toilet) attached, ideally to be used exclusively for *doping controls*, is required. If exclusivity is not possible, then the rooms must not be used for any other activity during the collection of samples and during the entire duration of doping control. The room must be capable of being locked. A waiting room adjoining is also advisable. The waiting room should be air-conditioned or have a fan. Overall, the doping control station should be a secured room out of bounds to all personnel not directly involved with doping control.



## 1 Waiting Room

- air conditioned or have a fan
- seating for competitors, competitors representatives, and chaperones
- water and soft drinks *in sealed containers*
- refrigerator or cooler for keeping refreshments cold
- magazines and/or equipped with a television
- garbage bin

## 2 Drug Control Room

- must also be *highly secure and lockable*
- ideally to be adjacent to the waiting room and the toilet
- *lockable fridge* for temporary storage of specimens
- gloves, scissors, paper towels, trash cans
- doping control stationery
- table and three chairs (Doping Control Official, competitor, competitor's representative)
- water, sink/faucet

## 3 Toilet

- *large enough for the chaperone* to be able to directly observe the competitor providing the sample
- a disabled persons toilet is ideal but not essential
- to be *used exclusively for doping controls*
