

**ISU Anti-Doping Program:
Promoting Fair Sports and Protecting Athletes**

Working in collaboration with the World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA), the ISU has developed since 1999 an extensive anti-doping program including in and out-of-competition urine and blood tests. In the 2010-2011 season the ISU carried out nearly 2400 anti-doping tests, with WADA carrying out a further 51 out-of-competition tests on ISU athletes.

Specific anti-doping information for 2010-2011:
