decided in telephone conference from 29. September 2005:

The appeal is not upheld. Boat 66 Tem Sony remain disqualified

Grounds

The Appeal is invalid. The Appellant exceeded the time limit to enter all documents and fees which is determined by rule 405.05 of the pleasure navigation rules. His notification of intention to appeal was received by the U.I.M. office at 5. September 2005. The time limit of ten days from the day, the notice to appeal was received ended on 15. September 2005. The appeal fee was credited on the U.I.M.'s bank account on 21. September 2005. As evidence of payment the Appellant submitted a document of his bank in Italian language concerning this payment. This document was dated by the bank and received by the U.I.M. office at 19. September 2005 also after the expiry of the term stipulated in rule 405.05.
