

History of the Waseley Wobbler (formerly the North Worcestershire Hill Race)

In the early 1980's B&R staged the 15-mile hill race for several years over the Lickey, Waseley, Romsley and Clent Hills. Following a gap the race was resurrected by the present organisers in 1989 as a 14-mile event essentially over the same course. Despite its appeal to some it was a tough course that many declared "once is enough" and it was reborn as a 10-mile hill race in 1992. This proved a popular change but in 2000 the local police decided that traffic conditions had become such that they would no longer sanction a particular road crossing. Unfortunately there was just no way around this and the race was cancelled at short notice. After eventually accepting the situation we 'let-go' of the past and started again and have developed an entirely new event with full approval from the police and the local authority. The new course runs completely within the area of the Waseley and Lickey Hills and is varied and attractive to run. It has been reduced to 8 miles but contains four serious climbs. There is approximately 2700 metres of road and the rest is a mixture of open parkland, field paths and woods with mud likely in October. This course has been used since except for small diversions due to foot & mouth restrictions one year. In 2009 the race was renamed the Waseley Wobbler.

Note: Not suitable for spikes. Stud or waffle shoes advisable.
