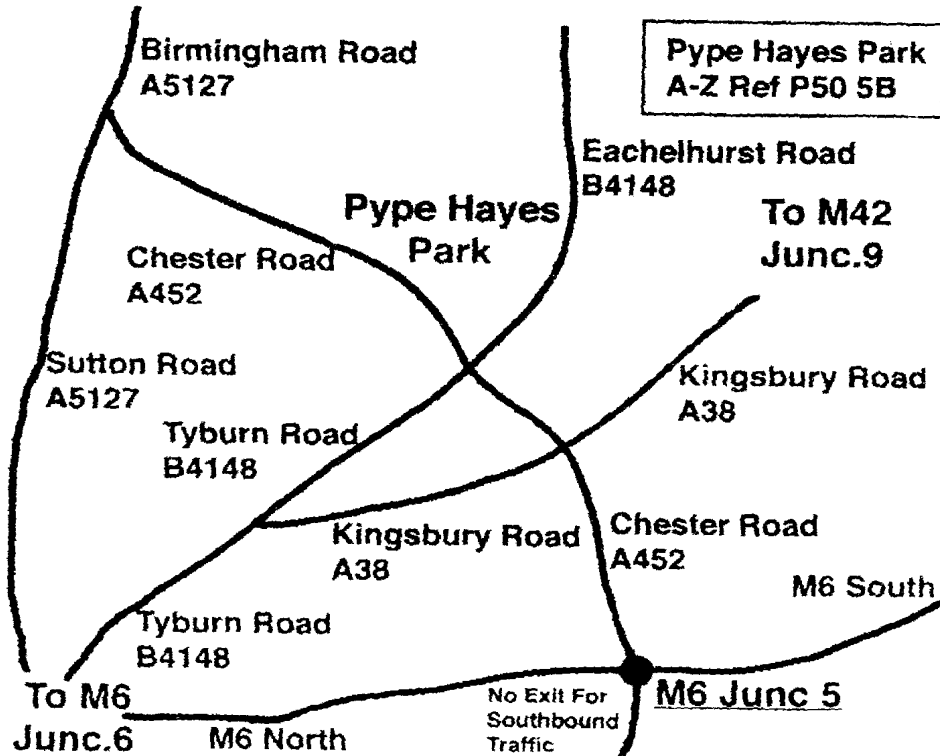

Directions From North

Leave M6 at Junc.6 (No exit at Junc.5 for Southbound traffic) follow signs for B4148 Tyburn Road. Do not follow main road at Junction with A38 Kingsbury Road go straight on. Follow Tyburn Road to Junction with Chester Road. Pype Hayes Park is on the opposite side of the road.

Directions From South

Leave M6 at Junc.5 at island turn right onto A452 Chester Road Follow A452 to Junction with Tyburn Road/Eachelhurst Road Pype Hayes Park is on right hand side of road. **Parking** (Please do not use the car park as this is very small) There are no parking restrictions on the roads around the park. You can park on both sides of the dual carriage way along Tyburn Road and Eachelhurst Road
