



Men's North/South Premiership Stats sheet instructions:

The sheet is comprised of three parts:

- 1.The team sheet form
- 2.The in-game stats form
- 3.The post game summary (optional)

1.The team sheet section should be filled out by the statistician PRIOR to the start of the fixture. All players must be registered with the appropriate club. Upon the completion of the fixture the team sheet should be signed by the head referee, each team's coach or captain, and the statistician.

2. The in game stats form should be filled out in the following format (examples have been provided in each category):

General rules: The home team stats are to be filled out in the green boxes, the away in red.

Each stat is recorded by writing the appropriate player's number in a box.

The various stat categories are filled out left to right, starting in the appropriate quarter. Each category has additional lines below should you need them.

FACE OFFS:

The home team face-off man's number (14) should be inserted into the the top box of the upper face off row, and the opposing face off man (32) directly below:

After a face-off, the player winning control of the face off should have his number circled. If there is no clear winner then the player who's team garnered possession should be awarded that particular face off. Note, face-offs resulting in a reface are not recorded.

SHOTS:

The home team shots should be recorded in the green shots box, starting in the appropriate quarter. Every time a shot is taken the relevant player's number should be recorded in the "SHOTS" column. Once a shot has been recorded the three boxes immediately below become available to record the outcome of that particular shot:

Above is the recording of four separate shots by four different players (numbers 16, 14, 11 and 3). In the first instance number 16 took a shot that missed the goal, i.e. he did not score or induce a save from the goalkeeper, so he is credited with a "SHOT". Number 14 took a shot that was on target, so he is credited with both a "SHOT" and a "SHOT ON GOAL", but he failed to score i.e. the Goalkeeper made a save. Number 11 took a shot and scored and is therefore credited with a "SHOT", a "SHOT ON GOAL", and a "GOAL". In the final scenario, number 3 has shot and scored, just as number 11 had, but was assisted by number 7, who is therefore credited with an "ASSIST". Note: Shots that hit the post or the crossbar, if untouched by the Goalkeeper, and rebound back into the field of play do not qualify as a "SHOT ON TARGET".

PENALTIES:

The home teams' penalties are recorded in the green penalties box, starting in the appropriate quarter. Each time a player is sent off, his number should be entered, with the duration of the penalty recorded below, and the number of goals conceded, if any, during the penalty:

There are three penalties above, by numbers 16, 8 and 45. Number 16 has incurred a 30 second technical penalty (shown here as 0.5 or half a minute). The opposition did not score any goals resulting from the penalty. Number 8 incurred a 1 minute personal foul, during which time the opposition scored 1 goal. Number 45 incurred a 3 minute expulsion foul, during which time the opposition scored 2 goals. Note opposition goals are recorded in the "SHOTS" section as normal. There is no facility to record a goal that is scored by a team that is itself man-down.

3. The post game summary sheet will always be collated by the ELA, but the statistician may fill it out, in part or completely, to give immediate feedback.

The quarter and final scores can be completed using the GOALS section

The Goals summary section allows you to record the numbers of goals scored by individual scorers. There is space for two numbers, separated by a dash, the first number should be the shirt number of the scorer, the second the total number of goals the individual scored in the contest.

The Assists summary section should be filled out in the same manner as the Goals summary section.

The Shots summary is completed by counting the total number of shots for each team from the SHOTS section.

The Shots on Goal summary is completed in the identical manner using the SHOTS ON GOAL section.

The Saves summary is completed by subtracting the number of GOALS allowed by a keeper from the number of SHOTS ON GOAL on that keeper.

The Penalties summary is completed with two numbers, separated by a dash, the first being the total number of individual penalties accrued in the PENALTIES section, the second being the TOTAL time of penalties served by the team in question throughout the whole contest.

The Man Up Opportunities summary is completed with two numbers, the first being the number of goals scored by a team whilst man-up and the second the total number of man-up opportunities (i.e. opposition penalties) accumulated during the game. Note: Concurrent penalties, i.e. multiple penalties overlapping each other only count as a single Man Up Opportunity.

The Faceoff summary is completed by two numbers, separated by a dash, the first being the number of face-offs won by the team, the second being the total number of faceoffs occurring in the contest.

There has been an additional notes section added to the summary page to allow the statistician to record unusual events that are relevant to certain stats e.g. replacement goalies due to injury.
