Time	Commentary
70:00	FULL TIME: USA with a huge win in the context of the tournament. They are within sight of a semi final spot.
67:50	USA content to play the ball up CHI`s end of the pitch
67:41	USA alert in defence and Rachel DAWSON makes good tackle on the right
64:28	Goal USA Goal. From a free hit near the left edge of the circle, O`DONNELL remains low and guides the deflection into the goal from mid-circle
63:52	Near miss for CHI. Bad turnover by USA gave INFANTE the ball at inside left. She ran 30m to the backline and drew the ball across the face of goal only to find that no support was there
61:59	USA continue to control play in CHI half
61:08	USA striving for the decisive goal and putting the CHI defence under enormous pressure
60:59	GRANT (USA) again threatens but she takes too long inside the circle and is dispossessed
60:25	Narrow miss for USA after O`DONNELL showed good strength to ride attempted tackles
57:44	Goal USA Goal. CRANDALL crushes the hit and it deflects high enough off a CHI stick to sail over the helpless CHI GK
57:00	USA PC. CRANDALL (USA) is pushed in the back while in possession outside the circle and USA awarded PC
55:35	CHI counter attack but USA defence holds firm
54:48	Strong defence inside their circle stops USA as striker looked to turn onto the reverse and shoot from the top right of the circle
52:08	Good interception by USA GK blocks variation to the left post
51:21	CHI PC. CHI PC after ball hits foot of USA defender close to goal
50:57	Untidy period of play from both teams with one turnover after another
48:57	USA slightly on top but CHI appear able to put pressure on the USA defence

46:01	Ball transferred around to the left but USA shift their defence and come up with the ball
45:28	CHI press down the right and win free hit near circle
41:21	Goal USA Goal. Brilliant solo run and skills by Katie GRANT into the circle from the right sets up Katie O'DONNELL for the tap-in from close range. GRANT took the ball near the 25 and beat three defenders on an unstoppable run into the circle.
40:42	CHI win ball with calm defence
40:22	USA working ball around pitch just inside CHI half
39:46	Variation to the left lacks execution and CHI have time to cover
39:11	USA PC
38:59	USA start the half in menacing mood
37:56	USA breaks free with overlap down the inside right channel but CHI GK leaves her lines and blocks the movement mid-circle
35:24	CHI begin 2nd half with surge into the circle but lose control at vital moment
35:00	HALF TIME: Lapse of concentration by USA gives CHI goal midway through the half. USA with better of play but have nothing to show for it on the scoreboard
31:33	USA press forward and win long corner on the right
29:13	The goal, scored against the run of play, has given CHI a boost. USA are on the back foot
28:45	USA defenders loses opposite players at the interchange bench down the right wing but CHI can't control the ball as it enters the USA circle
26:55	Tough tackle inside circle makes ball squeeze to the side on the left which is then cleared by CHI
26:12	USA keep the pressure on with free hit at top of circle
25:48	Diving stick save by CHI GK from the low drag flick. CHI clear
25:15	Repeat PC. First shot saved by CHI GK but defence can't clear
24:44	USA PC. USA respond with run up the left to earn PC
23:36	Goal CHI Goal. Poor USA defence allows Denise INFANTE run follow the path in to the circle from the left and sneak the ball to the right of USA GK Katherine BLAIR
23:06	Poor option in attack gives ball straight back to USA
22:49	CHI finally cause USA turnover and get ball from sideline in opposition territory
21:51	CHI haven't been able to control the ball inside the USA 25 for last 10 minutes
20:21	Bad execution on the push out by USA gives CHI easy ball
19:53	USA PC. Finally the weight of possession gives USA chance from the set piece
19:28	Good tackle by CHI prevents USA entering the circle but they again turn ball over and give USA possession
18:54	USA methodically working ball upfield
16:45	USA working hard off the ball to present as an option. CHI marking well to limit the space on the lead for USA strikers
14:57	CHI GK Claudia SCHULER forced to make low save on the left post as ball came

	in from the edge of the circle. USA nearly broke through
14:09	USA pressure in CHI half giving it good ball in attacking position
12:22	Slow pace of play. USA deliberate when in possession
11:56	Neat turn at the top of the circle by CRANDALL (USA) is countered by CHI, who win ball and take it up right sideline
10:38	USA pass across the circle from the right travels through a wall of players to the opposite sideline. USA keep possession and look to attack
09:15	CHI take ball quickly into USA circle and after blocked shot from an acute angle on the right, CHI push ball over backline
08:39	Good ball by Lauren CRANDALL gets in behind CHI defence but USA striker can't handle. CHI counter attack
07:48	USA more assured on the ball than CHI. Working their way into the match with good composure
07:18	USA probing from midfield but unable to find their strikers on the lead
06:08	CHI waste possession deep in USA territory
04:42	Ball worked from left to right across the 25 but USA right winger loses control and CHI clears
04:14	CHI turnover gives USA good possession in dangerous territory
03:44	CHI defence make the interception but struggle with the USA press to exit their half
03:14	USA work ball upfield with space in left midfield
02:39	Good run by Daniela CRAM (CHI) from the left into the circle ends when she loses control and ball goes over backline
01:06	Both teams with early possession but play stuck in midfield
