| 70:00 | FULL TIME: After losing in the last minute against NED on Sunday, AUS reverse the result and score in the final minute to win this match to keep them in contention for the semi finals. USA are still in a good position despite the loss |
| 69:28 | <b>Goal</b><br>AUS Goal. USA again do well to block the first hit but BLYTH follows up and smashes the ball high into the net  |
| 67:59 | AUS PC. KORNER beats her opponent after long ball from defence and wins PC   |
| 67:12 | Time running out for AUS with USA in control of the ball   |
| 66:47 | Composure inside the circle by DAWSON dispossesses KORNER and USA consolidate  |
| 66:02 | USA under tremendous pressure  |
| 65:38 | Lauren POWLEY (USA) gets out and blocks the AUS hit. USA clear but AUS pinning them in their territory   |
| 64:46 | AUS PC   |
| 61:48 | Realising they need a goal to preserve their slim semi finals chances, AUS have started to stretch out the USA defence by playing their strikers a lot higher  |
| 60:53 | HUBBLE with good save from powerfully struck drive   |
| 60:22 | USA PC. Good skills by CRANDALL to find foot of AUS defender   |
| 59:56 | USA take ball to edge of AUS circle and win free hit   |
| 58:06 | A period of possession for both teams but a minimal amount in good position  |
| 54:04 | AUS waste great chance. DAWSON was dispossessed near goal by PAMENTER but she couldn't convert a two-on-one opportunity and instead shot across the face of goal   |
| 52:24 | Both teams` fitness being tested with a much more physically demanding second half   |
| 51:46 | Danger for AUS as USA get shot away but HUBBLE pads ball away  |
| 50:32 | AUS regain ball and press again. PATERSON dives for the cross from the right but can't get a touch   |
| 49:09 | DAWSON again for USA with strong defence on the edge of the circle to dispossess Jayde TAYLOR  |
| 47:51 | More space available for both teams which is suiting AUS more  |
| 46:43 | USA waste possession and AUS work ball upfield   |
| 46:22 | Bad turnover by AUS nearly gives USA a chance. Ball cleared to sideline on the   |

| <b>44:57</b> | AUS cause turnover and Amy KORNER gets space in circle to shoot but her attempt is wildly off target to the right   |
| <b>44:24</b> | Raised pass from the left gives USA the ball  |
| <b>43:54</b> | USA take ball deep into AUS territory on the left but good AUS defence causes turnover. The counter attack is on  |
| <b>42:03</b> | The match has come to life with play buzzing from one end to the other  |
| <b>41:40</b> | AUS GK Kate HUBBLE has to block O`DONNELL`s run along the left back line  |
| <b>41:07</b> | PATERSON (AUS) flashes a shot across the face of goal from the right  |
| <b>40:40</b> | Shelly LIDDELOW busy for AUS up front but USA not giving her any room when she receives possession  |
| <b>39:59</b> | USA break from centre of the pitch but O`DONNELL loses control with one defender to beat  |
| <b>38:59</b> | McGURK`s hit is stopped by the USA GK and cleared   |
| <b>37:53</b> | AUS PC  |
| <b>37:43</b> | PAMENTER (AUS) beats two defenders, enters the circle and forces a pad save from USA GK   |
| <b>37:00</b> | McGURK covers for AUS as ball returns to midfield   |
| <b>36:39</b> | USA win ball and a good overhead down the right wing releases Katie O`DONNELL   |
| <b>36:04</b> | BLYTH intercepts inside the circle to put pressure on USA but they clear  |
| <b>35:01</b> | 2nd half underway   |
| <b>35:00</b> | HALF TIME: A very even half with neither side giving much away in defence   |
| <b>33:37</b> | Instinctive diving stick save by USA GK Katherine BLAIR saved a certain AUS goal on the left post after ball entered the circle from the right and kept being propelled towards goal  |
| <b>33:01</b> | AUS still on attack but USA stack players behind the ball to block the options into the circle  |
| <b>32:31</b> | AUS work ball into circle USA clear   |
| <b>31:32</b> | Great skills from GRANT (USA) has AUS scrambling inside circle but they manage to win possession  |
| <b>29:50</b> | AUS win attacking ball in midfield but Lori HILLMAN cleans up for USA   |
| <b>26:13</b> | Good chance for AUS but a late covering tackle from USA defence just gets to HOLLYWOOD in time to block her shot. Pass came from Kobie McGURK on the half way line to Susannah HARRIS on the edge of the circle to the right. HARRIS passed to HOLLYWOOD but she was too slow to get an effective shot away |
| <b>23:39</b> | AUS defence sets low and double-teams USA striker to win ball   |
| <b>23:16</b> | USA win long corner on right  |
| <b>22:47</b> | The match is lacking intensity and spark. Both teams are competitively matched which is creating a stalemate at this stage  |
| <b>21:03</b> | Quick pass gives GRANT (AUS) another chance to work on the right but pass into circle goes astray   |
| <b>19:11</b> | USA work ball into AUS danger zone but good low tackle in left defence stops runs of Katie GRANT (USA)  |

| <b>17:46</b> | AUS creating space for Kate HOLLYWOOD at inside right but USA covering  |
| <b>17:07</b> | BLYTH with a good midfield tackle on CRANDALL gives AUS ball just inside their own half   |
| <b>16:39</b> | AUS marginally getting on top   |
| <b>15:28</b> | Rachel DAWSON (USA) reads the play well and intercepts the ball to the right post   |
| <b>14:53</b> | AUS PC. Quick ball on the right gives Emma PATERSON time to work in the circle  |
| <b>14:05</b> | Ball travels across the AUS circle and they get a touch to send it to a long corner   |
| <b>13:42</b> | USA work ball up to the edge of the AUS circle  |
| <b>12:40</b> | Mis-hit by AUS on the variation to the left. USA win free hit   |
| <b>12:18</b> | AUS PC. AUS bring ball back into circle and win PC  |
| <b>11:48</b> | Again the USA defence inside their circle remains strong as the ball is cleared to the sideline   |
| <b>11:15</b> | AUS take ball into USA circle but USA make two good tackles   |
| <b>10:36</b> | Good battle developing between Lauren CRANDALL (USA) and Madonna BLYTH (AUS) in midfield  |
| <b>09:50</b> | Teams are still testing each other out with little flow to play   |
| <b>08:42</b> | AUS defensive strong around the circle to repel the USA attack  |
| <b>08:14</b> | AUS guilty of defensive turnovers which is giving USA attacking ball  |
| <b>05:42</b> | USA with slightly better of possession share but AUS not allowing them to penetrate   |
| <b>03:21</b> | AUS moving well off the ball to receive possession but USA alert to counter the leads   |
| <b>01:49</b> | Good tackle by Jacklyn EDDY (AUS) on the right blocks an early USA attack   |
| <b>01:08</b> | Both teams with early possession  |
| <b>00:01</b> | Match underway. AUS are still a chance for the semi finals but have no room for error. USA are the surprise of the tournament and deservedly lead Pool E.   |
