70:00	FULL TIME: GER with comfortable win to qualify for the semi finals
67:59	GER is no hurry to press ECO and they are merely throwing ball around the back
66:03	Incident Yellow card. Julia KARWATZKY (GER)
65:43	ECO again give playing time RITCHIE in the net
63:24	GER have two chances to convert but ECO just manages to defend
62:44	GER PC
61:08	Goal GER Goal. The pass comes from the left and HOFFMANN again scores near goal
58:43	MULLER`s goal should enusre GER qualify for the semi finals
57:53	Goal GER Goal. Julia MULLER drifts right and smashes the ball low past the ECO GK
57:16	GER PC
54:39	ECO defence harasses STOCKEL and give fellow defenders time to re-set and push GER backwards
53:45	GER can break through the ECO defence which has tightened and is playing well
46:44	GER have not regained the control of the match in the 2nd half. ECO with more ball and better field position
44:02	ECO GK saves the variation with pad and ECO quick to counter
43:35	GER PC. GER move from left to right and win PC deep inside circle near baseline on the right
43:02	Trap at the top of the circle is mishandled by ECO and GER win ball and race up the pitch
42:09	ECO PC
41:35	Neither team can keep control in a scrappy period of play
40:11	GER lose control inside the ECO circle
39:00	ECO get good ball in midfield but GER successful in breaking up the play
35:29	GER start 2nd half as they began the match; deep in ECO territory
35:01	2nd half underway

35:00	HALF TIME: GER dominant but unable to complement their efforts around the pitch in the goal scoring circle. After a very shaky start, ECO have settled well
34:11	ECO substitute GKs, with RAE replace by Claire RITCHIE
34:03	GER miss easy chance close to goal. Two attempts missed in quick succession
30:40	GER PC. Shot by Julia MULLER ruled too high. The PC broke down and travelled outside the circle (but not the required five yards) and MULLER stepped in a smashed the ball high into the net
27:56	Good tackle by Catriona FORREST (ECO) inside her own circle ends a GER attack from the right
26:57	ECO with rare entry into GER circle but defence clears without fuss and GER take control deep in own half
26:20	ECO starting to win more ball in midfield to build time in possession
22:15	ECO try to move forward but pass goes over sideline
21:54	GER now falling back to the half way
21:09	ECO showing their plan to transfer quickly around the back and attack along the opposite sideline to try and catch the GER defenders out of position
19:14	RAE (ECO GK) called into action with STOCKEL (GER) shooting on the reverse. Easily stopped and cleared by ECO
18:47	Another near miss for GER. STOCKEL passes in on the angle but the deflection was wide
17:57	ECO transfer from left to right but the straight ball goes over the back line
17:18	GER mistake gives ECO ball in attack
15:54	Goal GER Goal. Eileen HOFFMANN scores on the right post with an easy tap in. The variation went to the left before being hit across the face of the ECO defenders to HOFFMANN
15:29	GER PC. Stick obstruction by ECO inside circle earns GER their first PC
15:05	RAE forced in to a great instinctive save from deflection attempt. Ball was fired in from the inside right channel near the channel and GER got a faint touch that sent the ball quickly towards goal
13:20	GER stream into circle from the left but Jennifer PLASS shoots across the face of goal with an attempted flick on the run
12:14	ECO get control on halfway and look to attack up right wing
11:29	GER not meeting too much resistance entering their attacking zone bu ECO defenders forcing loose passes into circle
09:01	ECO not able to take possession inside GER territory with any control or authority
06:29	As expected, all pf the play is with GER as they continue to mount attacking movements
05:47	ECO forced to scramble after turnover deep in defence on right
04:38	ECO GK Catherine RAE blocks shot by Maike STOCKEL from the left. ECO clear
03:45	ECO chasing GER ball carriers but setting an effective wall in defence
01:50	GER with all the play - deep in ECO territory

01:13	Another chance but Lena JACOBI (GER) flashes her reverse stick wide of the left post from mid-circle
00:45	GER with early chance from acute angle on the left but shot hits side netting of goal
00:01	Match underway. A draw for GER enough for them to advance to the semi finals
