70:00	FULL TIME: AUS through to the semi finals after looking out of the tournament on Sunday. A great effort. They have played their way back into form with hard work
69:14	Goal ENG Goal. Alex DANSON from the restart with a a clinical finish
69:07	Goal AUS Goal. Kate HOLLYWOOD slips the stroke past the ENG GK
68:18	AUS PS. Lisa PAMENTER (AUS) pushed in the back
67:56	AUS playing ball in ENG territory
65:28	Goal AUS Goal. KORNER turns in BLYTH`'s free hit from the top of the circle to ensure AUS victory and semi final berth
64:48	ENG make goal line clearance after a length of the pitch run by AUS
64:15	Great stick save by Rheannin KELLY after CULLEN flicks towards the right post
62:52	ENG PC
60:54	Turnovers creeping into AUS game and ENG look to capitalise
60:25	Lucky let-off for AUS as turnover gave ENG chance to stretch AUS defence. Ball eventually over backline off AUS stick
59:27	Ball stuck in midfield
56:58	Mis-trap at top of the circle and ENG clear
56:32	AUS PC
55:33	AUS clear well from pads of GK from CULLEN`'s hit
54:53	ENG PC. Ball strikes foot of AUS defender
54:36	ENG free on left edge of circle
54:17	ENG not giving up and refuse to present AUS with an easy path to the semi finals
53:30	ENG runner blocks the shot
52:57	AUS PC

52:09	AUS efforts off the ball when ENG in possession suffocating their opposition. ENG dangerous on the counter attack once they have breached the midfield wall
51:11	Ball comes into circle from left and AUS narrowly miss with shot as ball slides wide of the right post
50:27	AUS well on top and in ENG half again
48:43	Play from one end to the other as ENG have chance and then AUS force save from GK
46:54	AUS won't let ENG out of defensive 25
46:18	Ball across the face of goal from right to left and ENG regain possession
45:58	AUS keep up pressure near circle
45:25	Emma PATERSON on the variation to the right has her shot saved by left pad of ENG GK
44:09	Repeat PC. McGURK's hit lifted off ENG stick
43:37	AUS PC. AUS breakaway only stopped by ENG foot inside circle
43:09	Good defence by AUS near own circle after turnover
40:52	ENG still probing the AUS right side defence but AUS are much quicker to shut down the attack in the 2nd half
38:30	McGURK is ok and AUS take ball upfield
37:54	CULLEN strikes McGURK and AUS break free but umpires stop time to check on AUS defender
37:04	ENG PC
35:24	Goal AUS Goal. AUS take ball from restart into circle on the left and KORNER scores from an acute angle
35:01	2nd half underway
35:00	FULL TIME: AUS lead in a very even half. Limited chances for both teams with AUS proficiency on PCs giving them the edge
34:53	ENG continue to attack AUS down left wing with good effect
34:12	McGURK gets to Crista CULLEN'S attempted flick. ENG take too long to take the shot
33:50	ENG PC
33:39	The hit goes astray and ENG break up the left wing
33:13	Another long corner on right for AUS
32:54	ENG win ball but AUS again intercept
32:39	AUS causing ENG to turn ball over in defence to build the pressure. Long corner for AUS on right
31:51	ENG get players behind the ball as AUS pass down right side travels over backline
31:15	AUS win ball and are quick to move into attack
30:58	AUS mistake gives ENG ball in good position
27:46	Goal AUS Goal. Shelly LIDDELOW nudges the ball in from the right post after McGURK'S shot hit the ENG GK and rolled over the top of her pads

27:18	AUS PC. Ball lifted off ENG in circle
26:55	ENG hit clear for long corner
26:34	AUS work ball upfield to edge of circle on the right
26:08	Similarly, Chloe ROGERS (ENG) is creating opportunities for the higher strikers down the inside left channel when ENG get turnover possession
24:05	AUS starting to get more run in the midfield, especially through Amy KORNER
22:53	ENG turn to waste chance with free hit deep in AUS territory raised into the circle
21:28	AUS cause turnover and ENG forced to clean up in own circle
21:06	Free hit from top of circle from Madonna BLYTH (AUS) goes over the backline without being touched
20:38	AUS striker slips marker and takes ball to edge of circle
18:04	ENG entry into circle again from the right but AUS remain alert and clear to half way from a potentially dangerous movement
17:07	Limited chances with well-set defences in control
14:25	Defence of ENG dispossess AUS attacker and they settle play with overhead out of their half
13:38	AUS intercept in midfield and stream forward on the left
12:31	ENG with good period of play, forcing AUS into errors and not giving them time in possession to develop attack
12:01	AUS turnover near halfway can't be controlled as ENG enter circle
11:22	AUS defend well and release up their right side
10:51	ENG move ball in midfield and find space down left wing
10:18	AUS clear after hit saved by AUS GK
09:51	Repeat PC. McGURK gets to the hit but ball lifts
09:17	Repeat PC. Same again. Deflection attempt up off AUS stick
08:47	Repeat PC. Ball lifted off AUS stick
08:29	ENG PC. ENG attack and force good save by AUS GK
08:04	Space in left midfield for AUS by ENF defender gets to ball first and ENG counter
06:54	Kobie McGURK's slap shot to the post for a deflection is blocked by the ENG runner
06:19	AUS PC
06:09	AUS take ball down right and set up with free in good position
04:30	AUS met by a wall of ENG defenders and ball returns to midfield
04:05	AUS turn to pressure ENG defence
03:13	From ENG long corner, ENG don't have enough players in the circle and AUS win ball and move upfield
02:29	Strong AUS defence clears ball but ENG force turnover
02:09	ENG first to take ball into opposition territory with free hit on left of circle
00:01	Match underway. Under tournament regulations and based on the result of the previous match between USA and ESP, AUS needs only to win to advance to the semi finals. Tournament regulations set down that if points are level, the team with the most wins at the end of the medal round will advance to the semi finals.
