Time	Commentary
70:00	The fulltime siren sounds, with GER beating KOR 5-1. The win wasn't as easy as the score line reflects, as KOR dominated for a lot of the match, especially the first two thirds. There were six individual goal scorers in the match. The loss for KOR means they are relegated from next year's Champions Trophy, with New Zealand coming in.
66:50	KELLER miss traps right in front, wasting chance for GER's sixth
65:10	GER looking for sixth goal, playing much better than early in the half
58:15	Goal KELLER doesn't shoot wide this time, finding the net with her reverse stick shot after GER countered from a KOR midfield turnover
57:37	KELLER reverse stick flick goes just wide
57:01	GER playing much better, with KUHN and MULLER playing well in midfield
53:21	FRANK saves Eun Sil KIM's shot
52:47	KOR PC
51:27	Goal GER's Kerstin HOYER scores her sides fourth, tapping in after a scrappy goal mouth scramble
49:03	Goal GER double their lead, totally against the run of play. Maike STOCKEL slapped her shot past MOON, making it 3-1 GER
48:28	KOR go straight back into attack
47:54	GER with rare attacking opportunity, but danger is cleared
47:00	PARK also continues to play well
46:18	Ko Woon OG playing well for KOR up front
45:47	Miss trap by Sang Hee GIM at the top of the circle wastes another chance for KOR
43:50	KOR waste golden opportunity to equalize, with FRANK saving well again after KOR had shot from close range right in front

39:57	KOR dominating the second half to date
39:25	KOR go close to scoring again
37:14	Goal KOR deservedly open their account. The first shot from the PC was blocked, but the second was easily tapped in on the back post by Mi Hyun PARK
36:07	KOR PC
35:51	KOR with another circle penetration early in the second half, but FRANK is quickly off her line to deny them again
35:01	KOR get the second half underway, and will be looking to convert their first half domination (17 circle penetrations to five, and five PC's to nil) as the crowd grows early on a bright Sunday morning
35:00	GER go to the break leading 2-0, with two early goals putting GER in the box seat to finish fifth. KOR is playing quite well, but are struggling to get past FRANK in the GER goal. KOR will be out of next years competition unless they can put on a good second half performance and turn the result around
34:51	Straight shot is deflected over off a KOR stick
34:17	KOR PC
34:06	FRANK blocks KOR cross
33:28	Play resumes as KUHN goes off with an injured elbow
32:20	Time out as GER's Anke KUHN is down injured
28:29	Tae Young HAN misses a reasonably easy reverse stick deflection on the left post
27:08	KOR earn PC after attacking down the right
26:40	GER's Tina BACHMANN is playing well and controlling play from the back
25:38	KOR flick over head to get out of deep defence
23:54	Natascha KELLER runs into the circle, but no GER player is able to get a stick on her cross
23:00	Bad back pass puts KOR back in attack
22:26	Good defending by Martina HEINLEIN clears the danger for GER
21:33	KOR on the counter attack
20:30	Both teams running through substitutions
17:47	Sloppy pass at the back turns the ball over for KOR
15:31	Goal GER double their lead, with Silke MULLER slapping the ball in from nine yards out
14:29	GER on the attack, with their shot going wide
11:03	KOR long corner
10:16	KOR earn another PC after ball gets stuck near FRANK
09:25	KOR earn another PC
08:28	An attempted lob is easily saved by GER's GK, Yvonne FRANK
07:13	KOR PC
04:32	Goal GER take the lead courtesy of Nadine ERNSTING-KRIENKE. A quickly taken free hit finds ERNSTING-KRIENKE open on the left post, with her deflection

	beating KOR`s GK Young Hui MOON.
03:55	GER free hit near the top of the circle
02:21	GER set high press on KOR defence
01:11	KOR on the attack early
00:01	It is all about Champions Trophy survival as GER and KOR take to the field for their fifth place play-off. The loser will be relegated from the 2006 Champions Trophy, so they will both be desperate to win, under beautiful sunny skies in Canberra
