Time	Commentary
69:58	Goal BEL remarkably grab a last second equalizer to the delight of their bench, who storm the field to celebrate. Jerome TRUYENS scored the important goal, flicking in from close range after the ball fell to him in the circle. PAK players and coaching staff members appeal to the umpire disputing the goal. The goal stands and the match finishes 2-2.
67:22	BRULE`s flick is deflected narrowly wide
66:37	BEL have a chance to tie it up with a PC
66:11	PAK continue trying to press BEL at the back
65:30	Both teams will be putting in all their efforts as the game hits its last five minutes
61:14	Goal BEL do hit back, with Jean-Philippe BRULE converting his drag flick. However the shot should have been saved, and was deflected in by AKBAR
60:45	BEL try to hit back through a PC
58:25	Goal PAK have their second, thanks to their captain Muhammad SAQLAIN. However it was the easiest of tap ins for SAQLAIN after the original shot got tangled up under DE GREVE
57:27	Game starting to open up as players from both teams begin to tire
55:16	HUSSAIN and Muhammad IMRAN are defending well for PAK on the left
49:38	Goal Adnan ZAKIR breaks the deadlock with a vital goal, 1-0 to PAK. Ghanzafar ALI makes a brilliant run from right half, which slices through BEL`s defence. He then lifts a pass into the circle that ZAKIR latches onto, quickly hitting a reverse stick shot into the net from nine yards out directly in front.
47:10	Loic VANDEWEGHE pushes a PAK player to the ground, then is spoken to by other PAK players as tempers seem to be close to boiling over
46:37	Incident

	TRUYENS is shown a green card for an aggressive tackle
44:44	BEL are happy to fall away instead of pressing when PAK have the ball in deep defence. It seems to be a common tactic against the skillful Paki`s, as the Canadians used it yesterday
43:08	At the other end BEL`s GK, Cedric DE GREVE, is quickly off his line to stop as PAK attacked along the back line
41:59	Dilawar HUSSAIN makes a brilliant one handed trap to negate a BEL cross into the circle
40:48	Benjamin VAN HOVE makes a good interception and run to put BEL on the offensive
38:31	Thomas VAN DEN BALCK is controlling play at the back for BEL. He has made several good tackles and has throw some good over head passes to outlet the ball
36:39	PK break
36:18	BEL with free hit on the right of the circle
35:13	PAK have an early chance to break the deadlock, but Mudassar Ali KHAN`s slap shot sprays widely away from goal
35:01	PAK and BEL will be hoping they can implement their coaches half time words of wisdom as the second half begins in Changzhou
35:00	A tough first half comes to an end, with neither side able to get on the scoreboard. There have been a number of time stoppages throughout the half as rough clashes with opposition players have caused injuries
33:51	PAK continue to push forward, but they are finding it hard to get into the BEL circle
30:53	PAK content throwing the ball around the back, however it comes un done with a bad pass over the sideline
29:36	AKBAR saves well to keep scores level
29:08	TRUYENS slaps a quick shot towards goal for BEL, which earns his side a PC as the ball strikes a PAK foot
24:48	Another time out as a PAK player is down after being struck by the ball
24:12	PAK with a free hit on the left near their attacking circle
22:15	Jerome TRUYENS has returned to the field for BEL with a patch above his right eye from an earlier knock
21:21	BEL`s PC is deflected wide for a long corner
20:17	BEL PC
17:39	There have been a number of time outs due to injuries to players, the latest occurring when two players collided badly near the top of the PAK circle
16:32	PAK have had the majority of field position and possession, but the BEL defence refuses to crack
05:48	BEL have their first good scoring chance of the match through Philippe GOLDBERG, but his run is stopped short of goal by PAK`s diving GK, Salman

04:43	PAK look for deflection on the left post, but it is well defended and cleared by BEL
03:51	PAK with the first good chance of the match with a PC.
00:01	The first match of day two sees an exciting match up, with two teams on maximum points in Pool A facing off, Pakistan (PAK) and Belgium (BEL). Weather has slightly improved from yesterday, but players are still forced to endure cold conditions.
