68:36	<b>Incident</b> Mohamed MOHAMED is given a yellow card for swinging his stick in his follow through at one of ENG`s players
66:43	OMRAN makes a good save to deny ENG a seventh
63:00	<b>Goal</b> MANTELL restores ENG`s five goal advantage by converting with a low drag flick
62:02	ENG earn another PC
61:42	Play is flowing from end-to-end as play has opened right up
55:47	<b>Goal</b> EGY please the crowd by getting one back through Sameh MOHAMED. Ahmed MOHAMED made a good run down the right before laying the ball back to Sameh MOHAMED to slap in from close range. 5-1
54:52	Ben HAWES` flick off the bunt is saved, with GOUDIE`s follow up going lamely wide
53:33	ENG earn a PC after a foot in the circle by EGY
51:37	ENG are running through their substitutions, making sure everyone gets plenty of field time in what will be an easy win
47:51	GOUDIE throws his stick to the ground in frustration as he skies a reverse stick

<b>45:10</b>	JONES returns to his feet and play resumes with ENG almost netting a goal from a free hit
<b>44:24</b>	Time out as JONES is down injured
<b>42:09</b>	ENG with a soft turnover passing around the back
<b>41:17</b>	Tempers are beginning to be tested as the EGY`s are putting in some tough challenges
<b>40:32</b>	EGY are trying hard to press the ENG backs, but are getting little success
<b>37:29</b>	<b>Goal</b> Richard ALEXANDER slaps in a reverse stick shot from close range to make it 5-0 to ENG
<b>36:45</b>	ENG have started the way they started the first by possessing the ball well
<b>35:01</b>	The teams have returned to the field for second half action
<b>35:00</b>	ENG go into the break with a commanding four goal lead. EGY`s coach will be asking for an improvement from his side when the second half begins
<b>33:01</b>	MANTELL`s high flick is well saved by OMRAN
<b>32:21</b>	CLARKE earns ENG a PC by pushing the ball onto a defenders foot
<b>28:28</b>	<b>Goal</b> ENG make the most of EGY`s broken down PC by streaking down field with numbers. Jonty CLARKE got the final touch into the net to score his first goal for the tournament. 4-0 ENG

<b>15:20</b>	EGY`s GK, Mohamed OMRAN, comes out to kick the ball and unfortunately hurts one of his team mates in the process. Time out while they both recover
<b>12:32</b>	PC is cleared
<b>11:43</b>	EGY win a PC after a bad tackle near the edge of the circle
<b>10:45</b>	EGY in attack, basically their first for the match
<b>08:09</b>	<b>Goal</b> Simon MANTELL makes it three for ENG with a powerful drag flick

<b>07:45</b>	PC ENG from outside the circle. EGY are going to have to settle or flood gates might open
<b>04:24</b>	<b>Goal</b> James TINDALL makes it two for ENG, scoring less a minute after their first
<b>03:05</b>	<b>Goal</b> Jerome GOUDIE scores the easiest of tap ins from right in front after a cross from the right. 1-0 ENG
<b>00:01</b>	Egypt (EGY) will be hoping they can bounce back from yesterday`s loss to Belgium as their match gets started against England (ENG). ENG will be hoping Simon MANTELL has his flicking radar with him again today and can add to his impressive four goal tally from day one.
