70:00	In a see-sawing game ENG have beaten CAN 5-3. ENG looked to be cruising leading 2-0, but CAN came back tying it up at 2-2. Three goals in a five minute spell early in the second half sealed the three points for ENG though.
68:44	ENG have two quick shots. Neither find the goal
67:56	ENG counter, with Martin JONES` shot being saved off the line
66:16	CAN long corner
65:51	Time out as CAN player is down hurt
65:26	Ball is cracked across and CAN narrowly miss deflecting it in the net. Still 5-3 ENG
64:13	Ball is cracked across but goes out of play on the far side
63:44	CAN free hit near back line on the edge of the circle
62:05	MIDDLETON is tackled trying to make a run into the circle
60:18	The variation doesn't come off
59:54	CAN earn a PC to the delight of their supporters that have turned out in the crowd
58:16	CAN`s spirits have lifted and they are pressing ENG`s defence seeking turnovers
54:07	Goal CAN goal. The first flick off the PC bounced off the cross bar towards the goal line, with Ken PEREIRA following it in to peg one back for CAN
52:50	Not this time. CAN PC
52:28	CAN appeals for a PC turned away
50:40	CAN have a long corner on the right

46:08	Goal ENG goal. ENG have hit a purple patch. This time Jonty CLARKE finds the back of the net to make it 5-2 ENG
42:17	Goal ENG goal. In very similar circumstances to the last goal TINDALL scores again with a deflection after a cross from the right
41:06	Goal ENG goal. ENG frustrations are short lived as they take the lead. Richard MANTELL comes up to take a free hit on the edge of the circle, with his powerful slap pass getting deflected in by James TINDALL. 3-2 ENG
40:03	The roles are reversed, as now ENG are upset at not being awarded a PC
38:13	CAN furious at not being awarded a PC
37:17	ENG are rotating through the midfield to try and make space to get through CAN`s defenses
35:01	ENG, who are back to their full complement of players, have first use of the ball as the second half gets underway
35:00	Amazingly the two teams go to the break level, 2-2. ENG totally dominated the half, but with the sending off of Richard ALEXANDER late on CAN were able to find the space they needed to create two goals.
32:41	Goal CAN goal. A very tricky variation at the top leads to the ball being passed to Rob SHORT on the right of the circle. His shot deflects off a defenders stick high into the net, leaving ENG`s GK, James FAIR, helplessly on the ground watching. 2-2
32:27	From the long corner they move the ball into the circle. PC CAN
31:56	CAN are playing with far more purpose and nearly win a PC. They do have a long corner though
28:45	Goal CAN goal. Michael LEE is quick to take advantage of CAN`s extra player, scoring with their first shot at goal for the match. 2-1 ENG
27:55	Incident ENG`s Richard ALEXANDER is yellow carded, and thus will have a spell on the side line after an incident in which a CAN player went down in the circle. Maybe now with a numerical advantage CAN might get a chance to attack
26:15	CAN are really struggling to play themselves into the match at all. They have hardly had possession of the ball over the halfway line
24:38	This time CAN are up to the challenge, with Richard MANTELL`s flick being saved on the line
23:51	HAWES makes a brilliant no look trap in the midfield. He is rewarded at the end of it by earning ENG another PC
22:41	ENG in attack again with a long corner
20:18	Goal ENG goal. Richard MANTELL comes up for the PC and gets the same result.

	His flick again goes to the right, this time mid way up the net. 2-0 ENG
19:53	From it ENG move into the circle and earn their second PC
19:17	ENG press CAN tightly in the corner and they turn the ball over. ENG side line hit in attack
18:06	ENG turnover passing around the back
14:58	Goal ENG goal. With their first PC of the match, Richard MANTELL fires a low drag flick to the right which beats MAHOOD. It is MANTELL`s seventh goal of the tournament. 1-0 ENG
14:42	CAN break. Another ENG PC
14:00	ENG move the ball into the circle and earn a PC
13:36	MIDDLETON clears the ball down the right wing for ENG
12:55	CAN in attack for almost the first time of the match
11:43	Ben HAWES is about to enter the field of play for ENG
10:33	Scott SANDISON makes a good low tackle for CAN at the back and CAN have the chance to use the ball
09:57	ENG long corner
08:40	ENG have had all the field position in the early stages
07:50	Barry MIDDLETON is involved in a good one two, which gives him space to fire a powerful shot. CAN`s GK, Mike MAHOOD, is up to the challenge and saves well
06:48	ENG break forward but CAN`s defence is up to it
05:30	CLARKE hobbles off the far side of the pitch and is replaced by Simon MANTELL
04:56	Time out as CLARKE is down injured after being struck by the ball on his leg
03:30	Jonty CLARKE is having trouble picking up passes from ENG`s back line, already miss trapping two
01:19	ENG have possession passing around their back four
