70:00	BEL hang on, just, for a 1-0 win. Despite dominating for most of the second half IRL were unable to break BEL`s water tight defence. JERMYN worked tirelessly to try and get IRL back in it, but in the end TRUYENS early goal was the difference
69:30	TRUYENS takes the ball to the corner of the field to waste time
68:48	IRL rushing to try and get one last chance to equalize
67:31	BEL have their first chance for a long time, but BROWN is there to cover
64:53	Andy BARBOUR narrowly misses a cross for IRL, which he would have scored had he got a stick on it
63:55	IRL have had all the ball, but BEL`s defence won`t crack
61:50	BUTLER`s flick deflects wide
61:20	From the long corner IRL earn another PC
60:58	JERMYN`s flick is saved. Long corner
60:05	BEL break early. Another PC
59:28	IRL PC
57:48	BEL making three substitutions for fresh legs on the pitch
56:06	IRL pressuring but good flat stick tackling is keeping them at bay
52:47	BEL with the ball at the back
52:22	JERMYN`s flick is saved. Long corner
51:59	IRL earn a PC through JERMYN
51:04	BEL with the ball on their left hand side
50:23	Time out as DE GREVE fixes his pads up
49:08	Strong defending from both teams is offering very few attacking opportunities
47:02	The ball goes out for a long corner
46:41	BEL free hit on the top of the circle
45:36	BEL`s Maxime LUYCX slaps a pass through the circle, but no one can get it going towards goal
43:30	Paddy BROWN has been heavily involved for IRL in the second half. Making

	tackles and a lot of short passes
42:40	IRL are running through their substitutions
41:20	The ball ends up in the goal and BEL go up with cheers, but umpire IGGO rules it to be a long corner
40:36	VANDEWEGHE makes a good run and wins BEL a free hit on the edge of the circle
39:53	IRL pass the ball well through their midfield and up into attack on the right
38:10	IRL appeals for a PS are turned away as JERMYN looked to have been tripped in the circle
36:13	BEL are patiently holding possession
35:01	After a lengthy delay awaiting BEL to return to the field, the second half begins
35:00	BEL lead by a goal to nil after an even first half. BEL were in control early, which is when they scored their goal, but IRL had several chances of their own later in the half. BEL 1-0 at the break
33:33	Incident
	TRUYENS puts in a tough challenge on BUTLER and is shown a green card for it
31:30	BUTLER`s flick is deflected high over the net
31:08	John JERMYN makes a good run down the right for IRL and the end up with a PC out of it
29:01	BUTLER`s low flick is saved by BEL`s GK, Cedric DE GREVE
28:13	A lazy miss trap onto a foot at the back allows IRL to earn a PC
27:12	IRL are trying hard to crack the BEL defence with runs around the back, especially down the right, but to no avail yet
25:46	IRL are falling away to halfway and allowing BEL to pass the ball freely at the back
24:12	BEL long corner
22:48	Charles VANDEWEGHE is causing a few problems for IRL`s defenders with his darting runs
21:52	BEL`s Philippe GOLDBERG has a shot at goal, but he hit it skyward over the top
20:05	Paddy BROWN makes an important interception for IRL
18:38	Stephen BUTLER comes back on for IRL
18:10	BEL with the ball in their right hand corner
16:51	IRL into attack
16:17	BEL cross goes un touched across the circle
14:00	BEL break down the second corner and counter attack, although it did seem to strike a BEL`s foot in the circle
13:14	The first shot is saved, but they win a second PC with the follow up as BEL lift the ball dangerously

12:16	From the free hit IRL win their first PC
11:55	IRL switch play well and drive down the left. They have a free hit near the edge of the circle
08:27	Goal BEL goal. BRULE`s high flick is saved for the third time, but the rebound falls to Jerome TRUYENS, who swats a baseball styled shot into the net.
07:34	BEL earn their third PC of the match.
06:42	BRULE`s flick is saved off the line on the defenders right post
05:16	BEL again earn a PC from down their right
03:59	Jean-Philippe BRULE`s low flick is save by IRL`s GK, Charlie HENDERSON
02:36	BEL work the ball down the right and earn a PC
01:44	Karl BURNS has started well for IRL by making a couple of tackles already
