60:40	NZL have Bradley SHAW back on the field after his yellow card
60:04	NZL long corner on the right
59:15	It is end to end hockey at the moment as FRA aren`t scared to counter
58:01	SHAW`s low flick is touched wide. Long corner NZL
57:11	NZL PC
57:01	NZL free hit right on the top of the circle
56:36	NZL are still playing very attackingly even though they are a man down

53:16	Incident Bradley SHAW is shown a yellow card by TEN CATE. NZL are down to ten for the next five minutes

42:56	NZL are starting to get frustrated with the umpiring decisions
42:24	FRA make a substitution
39:53	NZL clear the PC
38:56	FRA PC after WOOLFORD comes out to make a diving save and lifts the ball
38:08	NZL long corner
37:45	NZL have a good run of passing right from the back to get them into attack near the circle on the right
35:52	NZL give away easy possession with a wayward pass from the midfield
35:01	The second half gets underway with the crowd hoping it proves to as fast paced and exciting as the first
35:00	Halftime, FRA leading 4-2. In a very exciting first half FRA gained the ascendancy early before NZL hit back, but they managed to re gain it after two late goals.
34:41	Goal FRA goal. Just before the break FRA double their lead, with Julien BOYER scoring his second with a flick high into the net after he was passed the ball from the back line

21:25	NZL earn a PC after a good run from Bryce COLLINS down the right
20:23	NZL have a quick shot at goal, but it goes wide
18:58	FRA with possession at the back
18:00	FRA have a long corner
17:30	NZL have started to take control and are having a better run of field position
14:13	Goal NZL goal. The frantic start to the match continues, with NZL pulling one back via a field goal to Lloyd STEPHENSON
12:12	FRA free hit at the edge of the circle
10:33	Hayden SHAW's flick is well saved by FRA's GK, Julien THAMIN

09:14	A variation is saved, but the rebound is flicked back towards goal, with NZL appealing for a PS, but umpire TEN CATE only giving a long corner
