70:00	JERMYN's flick is deflected over and with it EGY win, 3-2. Amazing comeback from EGY late in the match, especially considering they had three players sent off with yellow cards during the match. Disappointment for IRL
69:41	IRL PC
69:38	<b>Incident</b> Ahmed MOHAMED is yellow carded for a bad tackle by GRIME
67:51	<b>Goal</b> EGY goal. EGY have suddenly played them into the game and taken the lead. The first shot on the corner was saved, but Mohamed MOHAMED swooped and slapped a high shot into the net on his reverse. 3-2 EGY
66:54	EGY PC
65:21	HENDERSON is down quickly to save Mohamed MOHAMED's flick
64:31	EGY PC
62:31	<b>Goal</b> EGY goal. With their only chance in the second half EGY have leveled the match. Hassan MOHAMED made a good trap on his reverse before making a run into the circle and firing a reverse stick shot between HENDERSON's legs. 2-2
60:36	Timothy COCKRAM goes off injured
59:21	PC is wasted with the trapper, BURNS, lifting the ball
58:33	IRL free hit on the edge of the circle leads to a PC
57:33	IRL have a free hit on the left in their attacking corner
54:43	IRL wasteful with another opportunity going forward
53:39	Both teams are struggling to get any fluency in their play
51:00	Paddy BROWN makes a good run out of trouble at the back for IRL
50:13	EGY long corner

<b>48:52</b>	IRL possessing the ball at the back
<b>46:34</b>	Ahmed MANDOUR is recalled to the action. EGY are back to 11 players on the pitch
<b>45:30</b>	EGY struggling to get over halfway in attack
<b>41:52</b>	EGY need to settle and worry less about the umpiring and more about playing
<b>39:06</b>	Amrou METWALLI returns to play after serving his suspension
<b>38:28</b>	<b>Incident</b> Ahmed MANDOUR is yellow carded for back chat to GRIME after the goal
<b>37:41</b>	<b>Goal</b> IRL goal. BUTLER's flick was run down but Karl BURNS quickly swoops on the bouncing ball at the top, smashing it into the back of the net to give IRL the lead, 2-1
<b>37:09</b>	IRL PC. EGY continue to argue with the umpires in the second half
<b>36:33</b>	IRL with a free hit on their left near the circle
<b>35:01</b>	Both sides were eagerly out onto the pitch two minutes before they had to be. The coaches have had their words, now it is time for the players to do the talking as the second half begins
<b>35:00</b>	Both teams are fired up and ready to go as they enter the halftime break. The umpires are going to have their work cut out for them keeping this match under control in the second half if play continues in this fashion. EGY have already had one player off and will have to watch their tackles and their mouths unless they want more players off. Good play to come back though, 1-1
<b>34:31</b>	<b>Goal</b> EGY goal. Despite being a player down EGY equalize, with Mohamed MOHAMED flicking low to the left. 1-1
<b>33:44</b>	EGY earn a PC for a lifted ball in the circle
<b>33:14</b>	The match is turning into a fiery affair, with both teams, especially EGY, getting upset at the umpires and opposition players
<b>30:40</b>	EGY in attack on the right
<b>29:17</b>	EGY's captain, Amrou METWALLI, is yellow carded by GRIME for barging in a tackle
<b>27:55</b>	A long corner is reversed for EGY back chatting
<b>27:10</b>	Jason BLACK makes a good tackle denying Ahmed MOHAMED on the edge of the circle
<b>25:33</b>	A free hit goes against EGY at the top of the circle for using their hand to stop the ball
<b>24:27</b>	EGY looking to strike back earn their first PC
<b>22:07</b>	<b>Goal</b> IRL goal. David HOBBS stepped on the field and was straight into the action. IRL broke quickly from halfway with a string of passes through the middle between HOBBS and JERMYN, with the later cracking a shot home from a tight

	angle on the right
<b>21:15</b>	IRL are controlling all the possession and field position but are having trouble penetrating EGY's circle
<b>18:20</b>	Timothy COCKRAM comes off the bench for IRL
<b>17:17</b>	Stephen BUTLER flings his flick wide
<b>16:40</b>	IRL PC for a defender lifting the ball
<b>15:35</b>	<b>Incident</b> Mohamed HOSNY for EGY is green carded by GRIME
<b>14:47</b>	JERMYN's flick is run down and on the second attempt and IRL player kicks the ball before shooting
<b>13:38</b>	IRL PC, the first for either team in the match
<b>13:03</b>	<b>Incident</b> John JERMYN is shown a green card
<b>10:27</b>	Turnover by IRL at the back
<b>09:54</b>	Ahmed MOHAMED makes a brilliant run beating four IRL defenders, but IRL's GK, Charlie HENDERSON, is ready for the shot
<b>08:36</b>	IRL with the ball at the back
<b>07:37</b>	Mark IRWIN draws a sharp stern whistle from umpire Murray GRIME and warned to watch his tackle. No card is shown though
<b>05:56</b>	The tall and quick Ahmed MOHAMED continues his impressive tournament looking dangerous in attack for EGY
<b>04:31</b>	Sloppy pass from IRL's Iain LEWERS gives EGY easy possession
<b>02:55</b>	EGY get the ball in the back of the net, but it is judged to of touched the attacker's body first. Free hit IRL
<b>00:01</b>	Ireland (IRL) will be looking to almost certainly book a berth in the 5-8 play-offs with a win over Egypt (EGY) in the opening match on day six in Changzhou. EGY on the other hand will be looking for their first win of the tournament, especially after going so close against Pakistan on Saturday. Play gets underway after a delay to apply extra water to parts of the pitch
