70:00	FRA records another good win by beating MAS 4-1. MAS weren't in the second half and had very few opportunities to score, unlike FRA who had plenty. FRA need a win tomorrow and they will qualify for the World Cup
68:32	FRA are playing with the ball in the corner running down the clock
68:01	BOYER cracks a reverse stick shot at IBRAHIM and it is chested away
66:52	Incident Arnoud JANSEN is yellow carded for a rough challenge. FRA down to ten
63:42	MAS in attack on the right
62:04	Muhamad Amin RAHIM loops his flick over the top
61:25	MAS earn a PC, their first of the match
57:12	Goal FRA goal. Terrible loose defending leads to FRA's fourth. The ball was cracked straight down the middle, with MAS's GK, Mohd Nasihin Nubli IBRAHIM, forced into a save. Sebastien JEAN-JEAN was then right there to knock in the rebound. 4-1 FRA
55:15	FRA keep rolling through their bench, making another three substitutions
54:33	Chua BOON HUAT returns to the field after serving his suspension
51:31	Goal FRA goal. With SOYEZ back on the field FRA have direction on their PC's again. SOYEZ fires a flick in the net high to the right. 3-1 FRA
51:05	SOYEZ hits a shot at goal which strikes a MAS foot. Another PC
50:25	FRA PC
49:51	Incident Chua BOON HUAT is yellow carded for a tackle on Antoine GOUEDARD-COMTE. MAS down to ten players
48:26	Matthieu DURCHON's diving attempt on goal goes high and wide

46:55	MAS are turning the ball over a lot as they try to come out from the back
44:54	Florent DURCHON takes a quick shot at the top after SOYEZ sets him up, but it deflects wide for a long corner
