Time	Commentary
70:00	End of the match. CAN win 2-1 and thus put Ireland in the 5-8 playoff. The win is well-deserved too, as CAN was clearly the better team, while EGY drew attention mostly through their indiscipline rather than their playing skills.
69:22	Upon the free hit, Sayed HAGAG performs a theatrical fall in the circle, but the umpires do not fall for it.
68:46	EGY attack down the left, but the CAN defense clears over the side line.
68:06	CAN are happy playing around the back and building up slowly. They just want to hold on to their three points.
66:20	CAN are back to eleven players, EGY are still down to ten.
65:54	SCHOLE to Rob SHORT to PEREIRA to the back for a buildup from the back.
65:20	Long corner for CAN.
61:54	<b>Incident</b> Yellow card for Tamer HUSSEIN for a bad tackle. EGY now have nine players on the field versus ten for CAN..
61:25	Another Mohamed MOHAMED flick is saved again by MAHOOD.
61:06	A good flick from Mohamed MOHAMED is saved by MAHOOD, but second PC follows.
60:07	PC for EGY.
59:55	A turnover in the CAN half gives the ball to PEREIRA who dashes down the middle. Near the circle he attempts to pass to GRIMES, but the ball is intercepted by the EGY defense.
57:19	<b>Incident</b> Yellow cards for Wayne FERNANDES and Hassan MOHAMED for their shoving match in the CAN circle at a free hit.
54:27	CAN get the chance to restore their two goal lead, when a pass is intercepted in midfield and the ball passed to Pete SHORT who is now in a two-on-one attack with Connor GRIMES. He passes the ball to GRIMES who decides to go for the reverse stick shot rather than pass the ball back to SHORT who faces an open goal, and his shot goes high and wide.

<b>52:40</b>	The EGY players are now playing more and more roughly. The CAN are protesting, but no cards are being given.
<b>51:09</b>	EGY are now on a roll. In the past few minutes, they have been attacking much and have got in the circle several times.
<b>46:09</b>	<b>Goal</b> EGY goal. EGY first get on the scoreboard when a long pass through the middle finds Hassan MOHAMED in the circle. He traps the ball in turning and continues to spin, leading Mike MAHOOD in the wrong direction, and pushing the ball in easily.
<b>43:15</b>	EGY on the counter attack get into the CAN circle but the CAN defense is unfazed.
<b>42:46</b>	A good variation again, giving the ball to Rob SHORT on the right. His shot is saved, but Pete SHORT is there for the rebound. He misses the bouncing ball.
<b>41:50</b>	PC for CAN.
<b>40:26</b>	<b>Incident</b> Yellow card for Amr AHMED after a rough tackle on Kenny PEREIRA.
<b>39:06</b>	Chance for CAN, brilliant solo run by Kenny PEREIRA, but his pass across the face of the goal finds no takers.
<b>37:00</b>	<b>Incident</b> Green card for Mohamed HOSNY for a rough tackle.
<b>35:57</b>	The shot is saved, and time is stopped for Ahmed MOHAMED who is down on the ground after having been hit on the head with a stick.
<b>35:26</b>	PC for EGY.
<b>35:01</b>	The second half of the game starts with a delay as EGY are tardy in coming back out of the change rooms. CAN had already been out on the field for two minutes, anxious to get on with the second half, when EGY reentered the field.
<b>35:00</b>	Halftime. CAN lead 2-0, and while this does not help CAN much, as they are certain to remain in the 9-12 bracket, the Irish team is sitting in the stands biting their nails, as a win for CAN, or even a draw, would put them in the elusive 5-8 playoff. But things are looking good for them as Canada have so far been the far better team in this encounter, and Egypt will have to improve their game by a couple of notches if they want to get something out of this match.
<b>34:43</b>	<b>Incident</b> Green card for Anthony Wright for physical play.
<b>33:37</b>	A shot on goal for EGY through Mohamed EL SAYED, a high shot from teh top of the circle, but MAHOOD clears easily.
<b>29:43</b>	And yet another opportunity for CAN, with Marian SCHOLE launching a high shot from a narrow angle, but it is deflected wide by goalkeeper OMRAN.
<b>27:21</b>	<b>Goal</b> CAN goal. The ball is passed on twice, finding Rob SHORT who has pushed up into the circle and scores easily with a light flick from the half-right.
<b>26:49</b>	Marian SCHOLE wins a PC for CAN.

<b>26:33</b>	Ahmed MOHAMED tries a solo run down the right, but again, Paul WETTCLAUFER keeps CAN safe.
<b>24:21</b>	The CAN forward line pushes up high and forces the EGY defense to a mistake. The ball goes to CAN but is quickly lost back to EGY.
<b>20:19</b>	Mohamed MOHAMED`s high flick is deflected wide by Mike MAHOOD.
<b>19:35</b>	PC for EGY.
<b>18:58</b>	In one of the rare good attacks for EGY, Mohammed HOSNY dashes down the right and tries to get in the circle but Pual WETTCLAUFER denies him and clears.
<b>13:49</b>	<b>Goal</b> CAN goal. The next attack finally nets CAN a goal, as they get into the circle and GRIMES slots the ball past Mohammed OMRAN`s feet catching the PAK goalkeeper on the wrong foot as he is just moving in the other direction.
<b>12:51</b>	Another circle penetration by CAN through Mark Pearson, but the EGY defense holds.
<b>11:02</b>	Connor Grimes` low hit is deflected wide.
<b>10:14</b>	PC for CAN.
<b>10:01</b>	Both teams are now playing a somewhat restrained game, trying not to give anything away, cautious in attack.
<b>06:30</b>	EGY have had a few promising attacks but have not yet had a shot on goal.
<b>06:06</b>	CAN`s initial burst of offense play seems over, the game is even now.
<b>04:47</b>	EGY are playing with an unusual lineup, leaving until-today-captain Amrou METWALLI in the stands, as well as not lining up Sameh MOHAMED.
<b>02:59</b>	CAN have a long corner, but the ball is intercepted by the EGY defense.
<b>01:01</b>	CAN start aggressively and put pressure on EGY early.
