70:00	CAN hang on to win 1-0. In a poor standard match neither team managed to create many goal chances. CAN will playoff for 9th tomorrow, while CHN will have to hope they can win one game this tournament to avoid the wooden spoon
68:08	A diving attempt at a deflection doesn't quite go in for CHN. They are just about out of time
65:05	CHN, who are yet to win a game this tournament, are going to need a goal very quickly, otherwise they are playing for the wooden spoon tomorrow
62:39	CHN have a free hit on their left in attack, the cross is not touched though
61:01	Hui Ren HU's flick is easily saved by PECK
59:51	CHN have their chance to hit back with a PC of their own
57:08	Goal CAN goal. The ball is bunted to the left on the PC, with Wayne FERNANDES flicking the ball low to the right. 1-0
56:28	SHORT does well in the middle of the park. He skillfully beats two defenders and then passes off to a player free on the right. It leads to CAN earning a PC
54:57	CHN continue to possess at the back. Both teams are really struggling to get the ball forward into attack
53:01	Marian SCHOLE has been heavily involved in the match recently for CAN in the inside left channel
49:34	CHN are patiently holding the ball
47:34	Yun Ze DE breaks free on goal, but PECK is quickly off his line to slide out and save the shot
46:48	CAN are told to call down by umpire PRASAD for some rough tackles
46:07	CHN run the ball along the back line and try to make a pass back towards the spot. The ball is lifted off a CHN players stick though and CAN get the free hit
41:43	CHN have had most of the possession. Li Guang TU is doing well at the back controlling play
39:23	The original flick was saved by PECK and then CAN were awarded a free hit for a bad challenge coming in
38:09	CHN win a PC to the delight of the crowd. The cheers and chanting continue in the stands

35:01	The teams have returned for the second half. If they game is tied at fulltime, there will be extra time to decide it
35:00	Neither side has been able to take an advantage throughout the half, with the score still locked 0-0. CHN have had slightly better chances, but have been unable to convert

07:42	CAN free hit on top of their attacking circle. The slap pass goes through the circle without a touch from anyone

02:31	CHN have started well too. Twice they have already been into their attacking circle. With one of those occasions leading to a shot being saved
01:15	Michael LEE has an early stab at a shot for CAN. He misses and CHN have the ball at the back
