70:00	ENG beats PAK 3-1 to secure third place, while PAK will have to settle for fourth. In an entertaining match both sides attacked freely, with less emphasis on defense with their World Cup fate already secured
66:38	ENG are looking to close down play over the closing minutes
66:21	Jon BLEBY goes off for ENG after being struck in the head accidentally
64:28	Goal ENG goal. Richard MANTELL steps up to the penalty spot and converts low to his left. 3-1 ENG
63:50	MANTELL's flick hit the postman on the foot. A penalty stroke is awarded
62:53	ENG have another PC. This time for a lifted ball off a PAK stick
61:38	HAWES has his shot smothered at impact which deflects it wide
61:01	Richard MANTELL's flick is just touched over by an out stretched AKBAR
60:27	ENG PC
59:36	Simon MANTELL's hit at goal is saved
59:16	ENG PC
58:51	ENG are getting lazy at the back. This time KHAN was left free on the right, but no one could get a good enough touch on his cross to get it heading towards goal
57:41	Dilawar HUSSAIN gets the ball with space in the circle, but he shoots across the face from wide on the left
56:31	ENG use a variation which gives HAWES a shot from close range on the left. It is saved and the follow up is fired wide
55:43	ENG PC
55:23	KHAN and ABBASI trade passes down field, but Richard MANTELL covers
54:25	MANTELL's flick is saved again, as is TINDALL's follow up
53:51	ENG earn another PC for a lifted ball after Richard MANTELL's flick was saved. They had two air swings at what would have been a tap in goal though

52:12	HAWES earns ENG a PC
49:56	Goal PAK goal. PAK are quick to get one back, with Mudassar Ali KHAN coolly slotting the ball into the bottom corner as he ran towards goal after receiving a pass into the circle from the left
47:57	Goal ENG goal. Glenn KIRKHAM passed the ball to Simon MANTELL in the circle, who turned and squeezed a shot high into the net. 2-0 ENG
46:36	Ben HAWES hits a reverse stick shot across goal, with Simon MANTELL narrowly missing a deflection that would have put ENG two up
43:59	ENG's GK, Jon EBSWORTH, who is playing his first match of the tournament saves the shot
43:10	PAK PC after ENG's Richard ALEXANDER makes a tackle from the wrong side outside the circle
40:47	Jonty CLARKE gets around a sliding AKBAR but cannot convert on his reverse from a tight angle
39:50	PAK think they have equalized with a deflection. Both teams protested as umpire Nigel IGGO was unsure. After consulting WRIGHT a long corner is given to PAK as the ball must of deflected of an ENG stick
37:14	Incident Umpire John WRIGHT shows ENG's Jon BLEBY a green card for a rough tackle
36:28	MIDDLETON has a good opportunity on top of the circle, but he can't find his team mate with the pass
35:01	ENG get the second half underway in the third place playoff. PAK will be hoping for quick goals this half
35:00	ENG courtesy of a late first half goal take the lead to the break. ENG have slightly had the better of play in an open and free flowing game
34:04	Goal ENG goal. Just before the break ENG take a deserved lead. James TINDALL fires in a quick shot from the top of the circle that AKBAR can only knock into the net. 1-0 ENG
33:25	PAK long corner
31:46	PAK break down the left with pace
30:27	ENG hold at halfway for a PAK 16 yard hit. PAK walk the ball up
29:13	ENG waste another chance as MIDDLETON was wide open on the left of the circle but they couldn't get the ball to him
28:21	ENG's Rob MOORE tries to shoot a reverse stick shot at goal but can't make contact with his diving attempt
26:18	PAK have a free hit near their attacking circle
22:43	PAK's Shakeel ABBASI makes a good run all the way from left half to the right wing

17:43	ENG have a chance heading forward after James TINDALL stole the ball of KHAN, but Simon MANTELL is tackled by one of only three defenders back
15:57	KHAN, who is wearing the captain's arm band in the absence of SAQLAIN today, is very heavily involved for PAK in the middle
13:28	Richard MANTELL's flick misses along the ground on the right
13:02	Salman AKBAR is called on to save a close range effort from Jerome GOUDIE. It gets tangled in AKBAR's pads though, ENG PC
10:37	ENG long corner
10:07	ENG have a free hit next to their circle
09:02	Barry MIDDLETON has had a heap of possession for ENG through their midfield early in this game
06:35	Mudassar Ali KHAN is surprised he doesn't earn a PC for a run into ENG's circle
06:00	Both teams are playing a very open style of play
04:25	PAK break down field showing off some of their flashy skills in the process. ENG defend their circle well though
03:23	ENG are looking pretty good early in attack
01:35	Incident Simon MANTELL receives a very early green card for using his body in a tackle
