FULL TIME: ENG win and join JPN in confirming their participation at the World Cup. A deserved result for ENG after their fourth straight win

68 Match winding down with ENG under no threat

66 ENG resume control after a brief attack by SCO

**** Goal: Sam JUDGE (SCO) ****

62 SCO Goal. Sam JUDGE given space at the top of the circle and she strikes a good reverse stick low into the right corner

**** Goal: Kate WALSH (ENG) ****

61 ENG Goal. Kate WALSH scores with her low flick taking a deflection of a SCO stick and dribbling into the net

60 ENG PC. From the long corner, ENG win another PC

60 CULLEN's flick is easily covered by the SCO GK

59 ENG PC

59 Yellow Card Helen GRANT (ENG) for deliberately playing the ball with her stick above her head

**** Goal: Lucilla WRIGHT (ENG) ****

56 ENG Goal. Lucilla WRIGHT scores with a neat deflection over the GK from mid-circle

56 ENG PC. Ball rolls onto the foot of a SCO defender inside the circle

55 SCO still defending stoutly in the face of persistent ENG attacks

51 Catriona FORREST makes a strong tackle in the circle to stop RICHARDSON inside the circle

49 SCO are battling to gain some momentum in the match but errors with the ball are ruining any chance they have to establish their rhythm

47 Missed trapped at the top of the circle by ENG gives SCO possession

47 ENG PC

45 SCO free hit at top of the circle is wasted when the ball travels over the backline

44 ENG win possession after SCO pass rolls over backline

44 SCO take ball down right wing and force ENG to defend inside their own circle

42 Turnover gives ENG ball in good position with SCO defence under considerable pressure

41 ENG take ball into attack but SCO win and possession and try again to take ball out of the territory

38 Linda CLEMENT makes good ground to block CULLEN's flick

- 38 ENG PC. Jennie BIMSON receives some heavy attention inside the circle and wins PC for ENG
- 36 ENG quick to take ball into attack but SCO win possession only to give it back
- 36 Second half underway
- 35 HALF TIME: A blistering start from ENG and they dominate to lead at the break
- 35 ENG in control of ball as half enters final minute
- 33 CULLEN's flick is saved and cleared to the sideline
- 32 ENG PC
- 30 SCO set up play with free hit deep in attack but the ENG defence forces them back and eventually a turnover results
- 27 WRIGHT almost scores her second in as many minutes with a diving deflection just missing

**** Goal: Lucilla WRIGHT (ENG) ****

- 26 ENG Goal. Lucilla WRIGHT flicks the rebound over a prone SCO GK from the penalty spot after the initial shot was blocked
- 25 ENG PC. Heavy tackle on Jo ELLIS results in an ENG PC
- 22 Cheryl VALENTINE causes a turnover for SCO but ENG recover quickly win back possession
- 20 SCO defence give GILLIAT-SMITH too much space but her reverse stick is sprayed well wide of the goal
- 18 ENG denied a goal after Cathy GILLIAT-SMITH is ruled to have played the ball too high with her stick from directly in front of goal after Helen RICHARDSON was allowed to run unchallenged into the circle
- 17 ENG in complete control with their movement off the ball and press on the SCO defence causing multiple turnovers
- 14 Yet another save from SCO GK after Alex DANSON eliminated her opponent and entered the circle from the right. MCLEOD was forced to make a save from point blank range
- 13 SCO GK forced to make another save after mis trap inside the circle gave Rebecca HERBERT a chance from close range on her reverse side
- 13 ENG not giving SCO any time on the ball to pick their passes

**** Goal: Rachel WALKER (ENG) ****

- 11 ENG Goal. Rachel WALKER flicks high into the net from close range after an initial shot was saved by the SCO GK
- 8 Play is based solely in SCO defensive half
- 7 Play halted while Louise MUNN (SCO) is helped from the pitch with a leg injury
- 6 SCO still under intense pressure from ENG
- 4 SCO yet to take ball into their attacking half with control
- 3 Good pad save by SCO GK Debbie MCLEOD from Crista CULLEN's flick
- 2 ENG PC. Pressure on the SCO defence causes turnover which ENG convert into a PC
- 1 First chance for ENG with a hit on the right edge of the circle deflected wide by Helen GRANT from close range
- 1 Match underway
- 0 ENG can claim a place at the World Cup with a win or a draw in this match. ENG

captain Kate WALSH is making her first appearance in the tournament after recovering from injury
