



**BDO Hockey World Cup - Men**  
**Friday 8 September**

- 70' KOR have bagged another three points in an entirely uneventful match. ENG cannot be content with the outcome even though KOR was the slightly better team.
- 70' R. MANTELL's flick to the right side of the goal is just wide.
- 70' Yellow card for Jong Bok CHA for repeatedly running out too early.
- 70' The flick hits a KOR player, a second PC is given.
- 70' DALY wins a PC for ENG.
- 69' YOU makes his way along the left side line but his pass for Nam Yong LEE is too fast and he can't get to it.
- 68' Yellow card for Woon Kon YEO for playign the ball after the whistle, thus trying to waste time.
- 67' Time is stopped for Martin JONES who has tried to find away through three KOR and has been hit in the face in the process. JONES is bleeding and has to be escorted off the field.
- 66' After a long time of being in defense, ENG are back on the attack now and have put some pressure on the KOR defense who clear with aimless long balls forward.
- 65' ENG have a free hit from just outside the circle but the ball is deflected wide.
- 62' KOR have a free hit from the edge of the circle. Yong Bae KIM plays it in but KIRKHAM clears.
- 61' Another free hit for KOR from about the same position. Nam Yong LEE picks it up and tries for a reverse stick shot but FAIR saves.
- \*\* Goal: Sung Hoon YOON \*\***
- 59' KOR goal. Free hit from the left. A hard hit finds Sung Hoon YOON who deflects the ball into the goal. FAIR reaches it but cannot keep it out.
- 57' Nam Yong LEE gets into the circle but ALEXANDER stops him.
- 56' For the past ten or fifteen minutes, play has by and large been confined to the ENG half but while KOR may have a firm grip on the game, they are so far unable to get a good shot on goal. ENG try for fast counter attacks but mostly fade in midfield.
- 55' YOU tries a reverse stick shot from a narrow angle from the left but the ball is not on target and umpire PUTRA awards it to ENG.
- 54' Green card for Martin JONES.
- 52' Free hit for KOR. The ball goes through the circle to Jong Bok CHA but instead of taking a shot he lays it off to YOU who is caught on the wrong foot and the ball goes out.
- 50' GOUDIE goes through the middle and plays the ball straight forward towards the goal. It is deflected off a KOR stick and goes wide. Long corner. The ball is lost to KOR.
- 49' KOR have a free hit from the far left. The ball is deflected up high and goes into the net. The KOR celebrate their goal but the umpires refer the decision to the video

umpire. Christian BLASCH rules no goal.

- 46' Yellow card for Eun Seong HONG. KOR had just been about to gain a bit of a foothold, pushing up farther than previously and putting pressure on ENG but they are now one man down. Will ENG be able to make use of this?
- 44' Promising attack down the right with WILSON, DALY and GARRARD but DALY's pass back for GARRARD is off the mark and the ball is lost to KOR.
- 41' R. MANTELL's semihigh flick to the right side of the goal goes wide.
- 40' PC for ENG after Yong Bae KIM tries to clear but the ball is high and hits an ENG player on the edge of the circle.
- 39' Time is briefly stopped when JONES and Chul KIM engage in an animated discussion when JONES claims to have been hit on the back of his head by KIM.
- 37' The second half gets underway much like the first, KOR playing around the back a lot, the two teams sparring in midfield a lot with no circle penetrations so far.
- 35' After this first half completely devoid of highlights, the two teams go into the change rooms without goals. It remains to be seen if the match will pick up speed in the second half - the first team to change gear will probably have a significant advantage.
- 32' The game entirely lacks flow, the action resembling a jerky stop-and-go more than anything else. The ball goes back and forth between the teams, neither of them able to string together more than a few passes.
- 31' ENG get close to the KOR circle for the first time in a while but cannot get anyone into a shooting position.
- 30' KOR play around the back for long stretches of time, trying to set up blitz attacks, but the ENG midfield is well positioned and usually stops the attacks long before they reach the circle.
- 29' Green card for Sung Hoon YOON.
- 29' Nam Yong LEE makes a quick dash through the middle but his ball into the circle is intercepted by R. MANTELL.
- 26' CLARKE makes his way down the far left side, the first serious attempt at an attack in a while, but his ball across finds no takers and hits the outside of the goal.
- 24' YOU tries a hit into the circle from the far right but Eun Seong HONG who the pass was for clashes with R. MANTELL on the circle line.
- 21' The game has characteristics of a checkmate. The teams are circling each other cautiously but neither has so far been able to gain any significant advantage. Circle penetrations have been scarce, the game mostly confined to midfield squabbles.
- 18' Good flick from JANG to the top left corner but it is slightly high and wide.
- 17' PC for KOR.
- 15' A good but certainly less frantic game than the previous match between Pakistan and New Zealand. Both teams appear a little reserved and are equal at this point.
- 10' A beautiful pass for YOON at the edge of the circle. He tries to shoot on goal but HAWES saves by taking the ball out from under him and denying him the attempt.
- 10' JONES is reprimanded for a rough tackle in midfield but not carded.
- 7' A pass into the ENG circle. SEO accepts the ball unaware of the better positioned YOU but his shot is saved by FAIR and cleared by MOORE.
- 5' Green card for Jong Ho SEO after a rough tackle.
- 3' ENG are the first to have a scoring opportunity with ALEXANDER dashing down the right and passing to WILSON but WILSON's shot is saved by KO.
- 0' Welcome to the second match of day 3 of the BDO Hockey World Cup. This is today's

only pool B clash, with Korea and England both on 3 points after their first round encounters.

- 0' The umpires in this match are Henrik EHLERS (DEN) and Sumesh PUTRA (CAN). The video umpire is Christian BLASCH (GER).
