70' FULL TIME - Jong Hyun JANG's late double snatches victory from the jaws of defeat. India can count themselves unlucky, but were overloaded following Prabodh TIRKEY's yellow card.

**** Goal: Jong Hyun JANG ****

68' It took a while for it to happen, but Jong Hyun JANG has picked up his second goal 5 minutes to surely give Korea victory

67' The corner is cleared by Korea, who break forward and win a PC of their own

66' Korea are trying everything to get the win, but leave themselves exposed at the back, and India win a penalty corner

**** Goal: Jong Hyun JANG ****

63' Finally Korea's penalty corners come good with a great flick inside the keepers left post. It should be an interesting last few minutes

62' KOR - PC

62' YELLOW CARD - Prabodh TIRKEY - Stick tackle

61' Chul KIM smashes a reverse stick shot into the roof of the net despite the umpire having blown his whistle for an infringement. Umpire PUTRA has stern words for the Korea player

58' KOR - PC: Korea seem to get one right, with the ball eventually hitting an indian player on the line. A penalty stroke is awarded, then reversed for a high hit following consultation between the umpires. The luck does not seem to be with Korea today.

54' KOR - PC: The Korean penalty corner routines have let them down in this match, and another chance goes to waste

52' KOR - PC: Yet another outstanding block from the penalty corner, this time from Vikram PILLAY, and India clear

49' Korea putting pressure on the Indian defence, but as has been the case for most of the match, India clear kill the danger with great defensive work

**** Goal: Shivendra SINGH ****

46' Shivendra SINGH puts the ball in the back of the net, but the umpire calls the video umpire into action. He confirms the goal, and the indian supporters go wild

46' Video Umpire Decision....

45' Following another excellent PC block, India break forward and surge into the KOR circle, but the shot is poor

44' KOR - PC

42' KOR - PC: the normally slick routine did not come off, and India clear

40' Raj Pal SINGH fires in a dangerous cross from the right, but is blocked well by defender Yong Bae KIM

- 38' Korea are trying to get some early penetrations into the circle, but again India are proving difficult to break down and deal with it comfortably
- 36' Second half underway
- 35' HALF TIME - Scoreless at the break, there is very little between the two sides. India have looked better in open play, but Korea look more threatening from PC's. An early goal in the second half might add a bit more fire to the occasion
- 31' IND - PC. VAKKALIGA's drag flick is powerful, but easily blocked by the Korean keeper
- 28' An overhead pass down the left releases Jong Ho SEO who shows great pace to beat his man, but again the India defence block out the threat
- 24' Korea PC - a sensational block by the first runner Ignace TIRKEY sees the ball bounce away to safety
- 23' Kor PC - Jong Hyun JANG's drag flick is saved on the line by an India defender, and cleared to safety
- 21' A poor pass from Shivendra SINGH ruins a great attacking opportunity for India, for which he holds his hands up in recognition of his error. Seconds later India are on the attack again but do not threaten the Korean goal
- 17' The game has opened up. There is much more space for the teams to play in, and both sides seem more keen on attacking. Korea currently on the attack
- 13' Korea break forward, eliminating the keeper but nobody is in the space where the pass is aimed or a goal would surely have been scored.
- 12' Two great passages of play from India cause problems for the Korean defence. Great pace and skill from Shivendra SINGH forces Dong Sik KO into action, and then Raj Pal SINGH fires just wide on his reverse. India are looking the more threatening
- 8' Tushar KHANDKER chases after a through ball for India, but it runs out of play and is of no threat to Korea.
- 7' A slow moving game currently, but it is still early! KANG has returned to the field of play
- 4' Korea's Seong Jung KANG receives an accidental blow to the face from the stick Tejbir SINGH, and leaves the pitch for treatment
- 3' Very little penetration from either team in these early exchanges, with both teams looking cautious.
