- 70' FULL TIME: Both KOR & GER make their way through to the semi-finals following a scoreless draw. GER looked the side more likely to take the victory, but KOR were solid in defence and both sides will look forward to the next stage.
- 67' Both teams are trying playing careful hockey now, knowing that the slightest mistake could cost them a place in the semi-finals. Timo WESS (C), who has had a great game at the back for GER, picks up a loose ball down the right and clears to safety
- 62' Free hit for KOR just outside the circle. The pass goes left, but Hyo Sik YOU looks for the foot instead of shooting, but GER block him out
- 59' KOR have managed to block out all that GER could throw at them for the time being, but GER look like they want the win in front of their passionate supporters
- 55' As it stands, the Netherlands are going to suffer from this score-line, and are currently 15 minutes away from failing to reach the semi-finals. However, a goal either way could change that
- 54' Matthias WITTHAUS is a fraction away from opening the scoring, just missing a cross from the left.
- 51' Moritz FUERSTE deflects a shot just wide of the goal. The game has finally come to life, and GER look the team likely to open the scoring.
- 49' The ball flies into the KOR goal which causes the home crowd to cheer, but no GER player got a touch on it in the circle
- 48' GER fire a pass into the circle which hits the side of the goal, resulting in a 16 hit for KOR
- 46' Booring from the crowd has begun again, as KOR pass the ball around the back keeping possession before eventually moving forward and winning a free hit right of the GER circle. GER block it out and move away
- 42' More great tackling from KOR, as they thwart an impressive looking GER move down the right
- 38' Carlos NEVADO has a great chance to open the scoring, but he puts his reverse stick effort way over the KOR bar, much to the disappointment of the home supporters
- 36' GER manage to restart the match with an immediate foul, due to players crossing the half way line before the ball is moved.
- 36' Second half underway
- 35' HALF TIME: GER have been trying to get forward, but KOR have looked impressive at the back throughout. GER too have look solid in defence, denying threatening runs from Woon Kon YEO & Jong Ho SEO
- 32' The GER crowd are unimpressed by KOR's decision to slap the ball around the back for long periods, but come to life when the home side retrieve the ball and beckon them forward

- 29' good play from GER's Carlos NEVADO down the left wins a corner, but again it is cleared up by KOR
- 26' Christopher ZELLER finally breaks through, and drives right before smashing a ball towards goal, cleared up by the KOR defence
- 25' GER are struggling to get anywhere near the KOR circle due to a well organised KOR defence
- 21' GREEN CARD: Bjoern EMMERLING for deliberately holding up play
- 18' As you would expect, it is an even contest, but Woon Kon YEO causes more GER panic. He beats three GER players down the left on his way into the circle, but his pass is wayward.
- 14' KOR spring to life, with Jong Ho SEO causing panic in the GER defence, but it is cleared by GER
- 12' GER having a great deal of possession again, with KOR seemingly content to let the home side knock the ball around the back whilst sitting deep.
- 9' GER have had the better of the opening period, but KOR are finding their way into the match. They win a free hit to the right of the GER circle, but opt to keep possession rather than firing aimlessly towards goal
- 6' Christopher ZELLER charges down the left and into the circle, but he gets underneath his reverse stick effort and this time it is an easy save for Myung Ho LEE
- 3' Christopher ZELLER strikes towards goal, saved spectacularly by Myung Ho LEE in the KOR goal. A good start by GER
- 1' Match underway: A draw would see both teams move into the semi finals
- 0' John WRIGHT is umpiring his 100th match today, and was presented with a Golden Whistle by FIH President Els Van Breda Vriesman before the match began
- 0' The umpires for this match are John WRIGHT (RSA) & Henrik EHLERS (DEN), with David LEIPER (SCO) as the video umpire.
