70' FULL TIME: ENG grab a chance to play for 5th place with a last minute winner from James TINDALL. It was the first time the team had been in front all match.

**\*\* Goal: James TINDALL \*\***

69' ENG have surely won it with a last minute corner variation, finished by James TINDALL

68' PC - ENG:

67' James TINDALL shows great determination to rob the defender of the ball before trying to beat the keeper, by PONTIFEX makes a well timed block

66' NZL free hit outside the circle is well defended by ENG

64' NZL have a brilliant chance to take the lead again, but FAIR makes a good block and the defenders volley the ball away to safety

62' ENG are now dominating, and are chasing the win

**\*\* Goal: Simon MANTELL \*\***

60' Simon MANTELL claims the goal when it looks like a NZL defender got the final touch. Barry MIDDLETON's excellent run around the back of the defence creates the goal

57' NZL well in control, putting ENG under much pressure

56' GREEN CARD: Phillip BURROWS (NZL), for a bad challenge on Barry MIDDLETON

**\*\* Goal: Simon CHILD \*\***

54' CHILD punishes ENG for not clearing the ball in the circle, smashing a low reverse stick shot past James FAIR to give NZL the lead once more

52' NZL attack down the left and win a free hit. The play is switched to the right but Richard MANTELL puts in a good tackle on Blair HOPPING

50' Hayden SHAW sends a 60 metre overhead pass, but it bounces to safety over the ENG back line

47' Rob MOORE sends a pass down the line to Matt DALY who tries to run into the circle, but is tackled well by Shea McALEESE

**\*\* Goal: Glenn KIRKHAM \*\***

45' A good attack sees KIRKHAM dive full length to reverse stick the ball into the net after Jerome GOUDIE's excellent run and shot is only parried by NZL keeper Kyle PONTIFEX.

43' ENG have been having the better of the second half so far, but are guilty of making inexplicable errors. Barry MIDDLETON runs the ball off the side of the pitch under no pressure.

41' Martin JONES finds acres of space in the circle, before slipping the ball to James TINDALL, but the striker fouls and NZL have the hit

- 39' Scott CORDON beats three men down the left and wins a free hit. Richard MANTELL slaps the ball into the circle but NZL clear
- 38' NZL move down the right, but the ball goes out of play for an ENG 16 hitout
- 36' SECOND HALF UNDERWAY: Reserve umpire Xavier ADELL (ESP) takes the place of Amarjit SINGH (MAS) who has suffered an injury
- 35' HALF TIME: A timely goal by ENG reduces the damage, keeping them within touching distance of NZL.

**\*\* Goal: Simon MANTELL \*\***

- 35' An overtime PC variation sees Ben HAWES shot come off the keepers' pads and Simon MANTELL flicks into the goal. Three goals in seven minutes is an exciting end to the first half
- 35' PC - ENG: ENG win a free hit at the top of the circle, smashed in by Richard MANTELL and a PC is awarded

**\*\* Goal: Ryan ARCHIBALD \*\***

- 33' Another flick from Hayden SHAW is touched in brilliantly by the captain Ryan ARCHIBALD for a 2-0 lead
- 32' PC - NZL: Bevan HARI hits the foot of Richard MANTELL
- 31' ENG lucky not to concede another PC as Jerome GOUDIE is guilty of a push in the back of an NZL player in the circle

**\*\* Goal: Hayden SHAW \*\***

- 28' A typically powerful drag flick goal from the big defender, which hits an ENG stick but still ends up in the goal
- 27' PC - NZL: Blair HOPPING shows quick thinking with a pass into Phillip BURROWS, who wins the PC
- 25' Ben HAWES passes the ball off the side of the field when under no pressure whatsoever. NZL have possession
- 23' Simon CHILD has a great effort from the right of the circle, well saved by James FAIR in the ENG goal
- 23' Rob MOORE's shot bounces off an NZL stick and hits him in the face. He is ok, but NZL lucky not to concede a PC
- 22' James TINDALL escapes a caution with a clumsy tackle behind near the half way line.
- 19' The game has turned into a fairly even contest after ENG dominated the opening 10 minutes of the game
- 16' Jerome GOUDIE cuts around the back from the right and passes to Simon MANTELL snap shot goes well wide of the target
- 15' Bevan HARI shows terrific pace down the right, but Ben HAWES tracks back and forces the NZL player into a mistake.
- 14' GREEN CARD: Bradley SHAW (NZL), foul on Martin JONES
- 13' PC - NZL: A poor corner from NZL, with the drag out forcing the stick stopper to move left. Richard ALEXANDER makes a good challenge and clears the danger
- 11' Simon CHILD moves down the left for NZL, but Richard MANTELL makes an impressive tackle to win the ball
- 9' NZL finally have their first real spell of possession, with Mitesh PATEL looking threatening down the right, but ENG regain control
- 8' Ben HAWES this time has a try, but well saved by Kyle PONTIFEX in the NZL goal.

Maybe the MANTELL option was too obvious?

7' Matt DALY flicks towards goal, well blocked but another PC awarded

7' PC - ENG: Good work from Martin JONES and Matt DALY forge out the first chance for Richard MANTELL's corner threat

5' Rob MOORE picks up a pass from Jonty CLARKE at the top of the circle and shoots just wide on his reverse stick

3' ENG Free hit right of circle taken by KIRKHAM blocked out by NZL

2' Strong start for ENG, immediately putting NZ on the back foot.

1' Match underway
