70' FULL TIME: KOR 4:2 ENG Korea deserving winners in this contest, showing more if the skilful, quick passing hockey from yesterday to defeat a tired looking England

**** Goal: Kate WALSH ****

70' Kate WALSH drag flicks a low shot underneath KIM to reduce the deficit, but it is the end of the game

69' PC - ENG:

68' KOR almost have a fifth goal with a shot that hits the post from a tight angle.

**** Goal: Seul Ki CHEON ****

68' A drag flick from Seul Ki CHEON finds the back of the net

67' PC - KOR:

65' ENG so close to scoring after a 10 pass move took them in front of goal, but goal keeping heroics from LIM keep the ball out of the goal. England win a PC which breaks down, and KOR almost score

58' PC - KOR: fired wide by Eun Sil KIM

56' Korea beginning to put ENG under pressure as they search for a fourth goal

52' Jo ELLIS strikes a fierce high shot towards goal as ENG continue to press, but it is cleared well by KOR

47' ENG are looking threatening, but are leaving themselves exposed at the back. Mi Hyun PARK brakes through but just fails to get onto the pass

43' PC to ENG: WALSH fails to get hold of the flick, and KOR break forward, but ENG clear the danger

41' CULLEN makes another error, but recovers well to make a spectacular tackle on Mi Hyun PARK

39' PC - KOR: The slip left deceives the ENG defence, but it hits a KOR foot and ENG clear

38' GREEN CARD: Rachel WALKER for what was interpreted as a deliberate trip

36' ENG concede a penalty corner less than 10 seconds into the half, but it is comfortably saved by ROBERTS.

36' Second half underway

35' KOR 3:1 ENG

33' Hye Sook CHO attempts an arial down the line, but manages to clear the stand instead

**** Goal: Eun Sil KIM ****

30' Eun Sil KIM punishes ENG for their error with a fierce, deflected strike

29' Hye Lyong HAN wins a PC for KOR following an ENG mistake, with WALSH

losing possession in her own half

25' Both teams seem to have settled down and are playing some good hockey. England certainly look capable of getting an equaliser, but they will need to keep Korea away from their circle if they are to stay in this game.

22' CULLEN makes a superb block in her circle, but goes down injured after colliding with another England player. She slowly gets to her feet and is fit to carry on

20' A great ball from WALSH sets Jo ELLIS away down the right, but KOR deal with it well and head forward

17' Hayley BROWN has a shot well blocked by the Korean keeper LIM, but it is still the Koreans who are looking most dangerous. England are looking nervous

15' England are on the attack, but Korea are looking incredibly dangerous on the counter-attack. GREEN CARD for Mel CLEWLOW for deliberately knocking the ball away

**** Goal: *Kim Jung HEE***

12' Korea move into a 2:1 lead with another open play strike... this game looks likely to be a thrilling contest

10' An incredible opening 10 minutes saw an evenly contested game burst into life when Crista CULLEN smashed an open play shot into the goal, before Hye Jin SEO equalised a moment later.
